

The Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization has processed the following administrative modifications to the FY 2020-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

TIP Administrative Modifications

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) requested the following modifications:

- ID# 02-997 Various locations on US 41 in Henderson County: Replacement of targeted guardrail end treatments (Grouped Project: Median guardrail/cable projects with no change to access) Add Construction (CN) in FY 2021 at a total cost of \$520,000. Costs will be funded with 100% Federal HSIP funding.
- ID# 02-998 Various interchanges in Henderson County: Replacement of targeted guardrail end treatments (Grouped Project: Median guardrail/cable projects with no change to access) Add Construction (CN) in FY 2021 at a total cost of \$335,000. Costs will be funded with 100% Federal HSIP funding.
