Your Adopt-a-Highway group is invited to join us for Fall Sweep Week, September 18-24, as our volunteers from across the state show unified support for a cleaner environment.

Please review your Adopt-a-Highway contract and encroachment permit for safety information and for proper procedures to follow during the outing.

Arrangements for obtaining trash bags and required safety vests may be made at the state maintenance facility in your county, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Please let them know the date and time your group plans to participate, as well as the number of participants expected.

Once you have completed your pickup, leave trash bags on the side of the highway. Maintenance crews will collect them for disposal. You should return your supplies and safety vests to the county maintenance facility and fill out and return the Cleanup Notification Report to the Adopt-a-Highway coordinator so we can document the credit for your group. Note: the Cleanup Notification Report is the only accounting method that we have to rely upon, and groups that fail to respond with the survey may be dropped from the program without notice.
