Questions/Answers

Q. Who will be responsible for in-lieu-of fees for waste sites?

A. The Cabinet will pay for these fees.

Q. Does the Cabinet already have a design of waste sites?

A. No.

Q. Will the contract end date be extended because of utility hold ups?

A. The contract end date will be extended on a day by day basis depending on circumstances.

Q. There are no provisions in the plans for temporary guardrail, will that be included?

A. Yes, a quantity will be provided as an addendum.

Q. Can we haul on KY 32 with articulated dump trucks?

A. Anything licensed can be used on roadways. The big trucks will be looked at on a case by case basis.

Q. Any quantities in the plans for sandstone use in wet areas?

A. No, this will be handled as directed in Geotechnical Note 11.

Q. The geotechnical notes state that both durable and non-durable shale shall be undercut. Is there a quantity in the plans for this quantity?

A. A quantity will be provided for undercut, but the cost will still be incidental to project earthwork as indicated in Geotechnical Note 13.

Q. What should be used as a replacement for durable sandstone if adequate quantity is not available?

A. Parcel 20 is a possible borrow site that is owned by the Cabinet.

Q. In the event a hazardous material is encountered within the proposed right of way, who is responsible for the cost of removal?

A. These will be handled on a case by case basis and paid for by the Cabinet.
