# 6.20 <u>REGISTRATION WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE BY A FOREIGN ENTITY</u>

Pursuant to KRS 176.085(1)(b), an agency, department, office, or political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall not award a state contract to a person that is a foreign entity required by KRS 14A.9-010 to obtain a certificate of authority to transact business in the Commonwealth ("certificate") from the Secretary of State under KRS14A.9-030 unless the person produces the certificate within fourteen (14) days of the bid or proposal opening. If the foreign entity is not required to obtain a certificate as provided in KRS 14A.9-010, the foreign entity should identify the applicable exception. Foreign entity is defined within KRS 14A.1-070.

For all foreign entities required to obtain a certificate of authority to transact business in the Commonwealth, if a copy of the certificate is not received by the contracting agency within the time frame identified above, the foreign entity's solicitation response shall be deemed non-responsive or the awarded contract shall be cancelled.

# 10.4 TREE CLEARING RESTRICTIONS

The DBT will only be allowed to clear trees on the project between October 15<sup>th</sup> thru March 31<sup>st</sup> without entering into a Indian Bat Consvervation Memorandum of Agreement (IBCMOA) with USFW.
