Special Note for Fixed Completion Date and Liquidated Damages I-75 Laurel County Item No. 11-2043.00

Contrary to Section 108.09, Liquidated Damages of \$5,000 per calendar day will be assessed for each day or fraction thereof work remains uncompleted beyond the Specified Completion Date. This project has a Fixed Completion Date of September 30, 2017.

In addition to the Liquidated Damages specified above, Liquidated Damages in the following amounts will be charged when a lane closure remains in place during the prohibited period outlined in the Traffic Control Plan:

Mainline: \$5,000 for the first hour or fraction thereof

\$10,000 for the second hour or fraction thereof \$20,000 for any additional hour or fraction thereof

Ramps: \$500 for the first hour or fraction thereof

\$1,500 any additional hour or fraction thereof

These hourly disincentives will still be in effect after the Fixed Completion Date and will be charged in addition to the \$5,000 per calender day if warranted. The contractor is expected to make every effort to complete the work in order to open the ramp or mainline lane closure within a specified timeframe.

Contrary to Section 108.09 of the Standard Specifications, the disincentive fee will be charged during those periods when seasonal limitations of the Contract prohibit the Contractor from working on a controlling item or operation. This includes the months from December through March.

All liquidated damages will be applied cumulatively.

All other applicable portions of Section 108 apply.

No paving operations will be allowed from October 30, 2016- April 1, 2017
