GENERAL PROJECT NOTE ON UTILITY PROTECTION

Utility coordination efforts determined that no significant utility relocation work is required to complete the project. Any work pertaining to these utility facilities is defined in the bid package and is to be carried out as instructed by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. The contractor will be responsible for any coordination or adjustments that are discussed or quantified in the proposal.

NOTE: DO NOT DISTURB THE FOLLOWING UTILITIES LOCATED WITHIN THE PROJECT DISTURB LIMITS

Louisville Gas & Electric (LG&E) electric transmission—an existing overhead transmission route runs along the north side of Taylorsville Road throughout the entire project length. **These facilities are not to be disturbed and will remain in place.**

Louisville Gas & Electric (LG&E) electric distribution—an existing overhead distribution route runs along the north side of Taylorsville Road throughout the entire project length. There is an underground electric duct that enters the project from the west side and follows the approximate Right-of-Way on the north side of Taylorsville Road; this line proceeds to a riser on a utility pole at approximate Taylorsville Road Lt. Station 537+36 where it becomes an overhead utility. In addition, there is an overhead crossing at approximate Taylorsville Road Station 537+45. The overhead line then proceeds southward through the entire project along the west edge of Old heady Road; this crossing and a portion of the overhead route are to be relocated (see the green section below). These facilities are not to be disturbed and will remain in place.

Louisville Gas & Electric (LG&E) gas—an existing 6-inch gas main runs along the south side of Taylorsville Road throughout the entire project length; portions of this gas main will be relocated (see the green section following). An existing 4-inch gas main tees off from the 6-inch gas main at approximate Taylorsville Road Rt. Station 537+30 and runs southward off the west pavement edge of Old Heady Road the entire length of the project. These facilities are not to be disturbed and will remain in place.

Metropolitan Sewer District (MSD)—an existing 12-inch PVC force main runs along the north side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) throughout the entire project length. There is a manhole at approximate Lt. Station 537+60 and a 4-inch PVC force main runs southward under the approximate east pavement edge of existing Old Heady Road throughout the project. These facilities are not to be disturbed and will remain in place.

Windstream (KDL)—has an overhead fiber optic line attached to the LG&E electric (distribution) poles throughout the project on the north side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road). Windstream also has an overhead line along the south side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) this line follows a route that starts at the relocated LG&E electric pole at Old Heady Road Lt. Station 55+19.3 and runs eastward throughout the project; portions of this overhead route will be relocated (see the green section following). These facilities are not to be disturbed and will remain in place.

TW Telecom—has an overhead fiber optic line attached to the LG&E electric (distribution) poles throughout the project on the north side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road). TW Telecom also has an overhead line along the south side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) this line follows a route that starts at the relocated LG&E electric pole at Old Heady Road Lt. Station 55+19.3 and runs eastward throughout the project; portions of this overhead route will be relocated (see the green section following). **These facilities are**

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not to be disturbed and will remain in place.

Insight—has an overhead fiber optic line attached to the LG&E electric (distribution) poles throughout the project on the north side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road). A buried 4-inch PVC duct runs the entire length of Old Heady Road on the east side. Insight also has an overhead line along the south side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) this line follows a route that starts at the relocated LG&E electric pole at Old Heady Road Lt. Station 55+19.3 and runs eastward throughout the project; portions of this overhead route will be relocated (see the green section following). **These facilities are not to be disturbed and will remain in place.**

AT&T KY—an existing buried fiber optic cable runs along the north side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) eastward from the west end of the project to a riser on a power at approximate Lt. Station 540+65. The buried line then continues eastward to manhole at Lt. Station 542+38. The buried fiber optic cable then proceeds southward and crosses under Taylorsville Road to a manhole at approximate Rt. Station 541+88.

The Contractor is fully responsible for protection of all utilities listed above

THE FOLLOWING COMPANIES ARE RELOCATING/ADJUSTING THEIR UTILITIES WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS AND WILL BE COMPLETE PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION

Louisville Gas & Electric (LG&E) electric—an overhead pole route will be relocated along the west side of Old Heady Road. The poles from approximately 95 feet south of the begin project limits to Lt. Station 55+19.3 along Old Heady Road are to be relocated. The relocation work maintains the same alignment, but eliminates a conflict with a utility pole and a proposed ditch, the relocation also provides for adequate vertical clearance in the vicinity of the proposed traffic signal. This work will be complete prior to April 5, 2013.

Louisville Gas & Electric (LG&E) gas—an existing 6-inch medium pressure plastic gas line will be relocated along the south side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) from approximate Rt. Station 533+50 to approximate Rt. Station 538+06. **This work will be complete prior to May 17, 2013**.

Windstream (KDL)—has an overhead fiber optic crossing across KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) at approximate Station 537+46 that is to be relocated. In addition, an overhead fiber optic line along the south side of Taylorsville Road from approximate Rt. Station 537+27 to approximate Rt. Station 539+05 will be relocated. In addition, Windstream has an overhead fiber optic line attached to the LG&E utility poles on the west side of Old Heady; this fiber optic line will be relocated onto the new utility poles set by LG&E. **This work will be complete prior to April 11, 2013**.

TW Telecom—has an overhead fiber optic crossing across KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) at approximate Station 537+46 that is to be relocated. In addition, an overhead fiber optic line along the south side of Taylorsville Road from approximate Rt. Station 537+27 to approximate Rt. Station 539+05 will be relocated. In addition, Windstream has an overhead fiber optic line attached to the LG&E utility poles on the west side of Old Heady; this fiber optic line will be relocated onto the new utility poles set by LG&E. **This work will be complete prior to April 19, 2013**.

Insight—has an overhead fiber optic crossing across KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) at approximate Station

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537+46 that is to be relocated. In addition, an overhead fiber optic line along the south side of Taylorsville Road from approximate Rt. Station 537+27 to approximate Rt. Station 539+05 will be relocated. In addition, Windstream has an overhead fiber optic line attached to the LG&E utility poles on the west side of Old Heady; this fiber optic line will be relocated onto the new utility poles set by LG&E. **This work will be complete prior to April 26, 2013**.

AT&T KY—has a buried fiber optic duct runs on the east side of the existing edge of pavement of Old Heady Road and proceeds northward to approximate Old Heady Road Rt. Station 55+45 where it changes alignment and proceeds eastward off of the south side of Taylorsville Road throughout the project. The buried fiber optic cable at the southwest corner of Old Heady Road at Taylorsville Road will be lowered to accommodate changes made to the drainage system. **This work will be complete prior to May 20, 2013**.

THE FOLLOWING COMPANIES HAVE FACILITIES TO BE RELOCATED/ADJUSTED BY THE ROAD CONTRACTOR AS INCLUDED IN THIS CONTRACT

Louisville Water Company (LWCo)—the existing 16-inch ductile iron water main along the south side of KY 155 (Taylorsville Road) will be relocated by the Contractor from approximate Rt. Station 5360+70 to approximate Rt. Station 540+65. This work will involve relocating one fire hydrant, and re-positioning a tie-in with the existing water line under the east side of Old Heady Road. The Contractor is to provide the 16-inch ductile iron pipe; all other fixtures and fittings will be provided by LWCo.

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SPECIAL CAUTION NOTE – PROTECTION OF UTILITIES

The contractor will be responsible for contacting all utility facility owners on the subject project to coordinate his activities. The contractor will coordinate his activities to minimize and, where possible, avoid conflicts with utility facilities. Due to the nature of the work proposed, it is unlikely to conflict with the existing utilities beyond minor facility adjustments. Where conflicts with utility facilities are unavoidable, the contractor will coordinate any necessary relocation work with the facility owner and Resident Engineer. The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet maintains the right to remove or alter portions of this contract if a utility conflict occurs.

The utility facilities as noted in the previous section(s) have been determined using data garnered by varied means and with varying degrees of accuracy: from the facility owners, a result of S.U.E., field inspections, and/or reviews of record drawings. The facilities defined may not be inclusive of all utilities in the project scope and are not Level A quality, unless specified as such. It is the contractor's responsibility to verify all utilities and their respective locations before excavating.

BEFORE YOU DIG

The contractor is instructed to call 1-800-752-6007 to reach KY 811, the one-call system for information on the location of existing underground utilities. The call is to be placed a minimum of two (2) and no more than ten (10) business days prior to excavation. The contractor should be aware that owners of underground facilities are not required to be members of the KY 811 one-call Before-U-Dig (BUD) service. The contractor must coordinate excavation with the utility owners, including those whom do not subscribe to KY 811. It may be necessary for the contractor to contact the County Court Clerk to determine what utility companies have facilities in the area.
