TRAFFIC CONTROL GENERAL

Except as provided herein, traffic shall be maintained in accordance with the current Standard Specifications and the Standard Drawings, current editions. Except for the roadway and traffic control bid items listed, all items of work necessary to maintain and control traffic will be paid at the lump sum bid price to "Maintain and Control Traffic".

Contrary to Section 106.01, traffic control devices used on this project may be new, or used in like new condition, at the beginning of the work and maintained in like new condition until completion of the work.

PROJECT PHASING & CONSTRUCTION PROCEDURES

All lanes shall be open to traffic and no work will be allowed between the hours of 6 A.M. and 8 P.M. Monday through Friday. Night work will be required on the project. Minor operations that require only a single lane closure and cause little disruption to traffic may be allowed weekdays between the hours of 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. with written permission from the engineer. The Contractor is advised to take these restrictions into account in his bid. No additional payment will be allowed for any delays to the contractor as a result of these restrictions.

No lane closures will be allowed on the following days or nights:

May 25-27, 2024 Memorial Day Weekend Sept. 3 & 4, 2023 Labor Day Weekend

At the discretion of the Engineer, other days and hours may be specified when lane closures will not be allowed.

Maintain a minimum of one traffic lane (mainline) in each direction at all times during construction. The clear lane width shall be 10 feet where possible. If traffic should be stopped due to construction operations, and a school bus on an official run arrives on the scene, the Contractor shall make provisions for the passage of the bus as quickly as possible.

Do not leave lane closures in place during non-working hours.

SIGNS

Sign posts and splices shall be compliant with NCHRP 350 or MASH. Manufacturer's documentation validating this compliance shall be provided to the Engineer prior to installation. Signs, including any splices, shall be installed according to manufacturer's specifications and installation recommendations. Contrary to section 112.04.02, only long-term signs (signs intended to be continuously in place for more than 3 days) will be measured for payment. Short-term signs
