SPECIAL NOTE FOR EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL

SPECIAL NOTE FOR GEOGRID REINFORCEMENT

DESCRIPTION

THIS SPECIAL NOTE COVERS GEOGRID USED FOR REINFORCEMENT OF SUBGRADE AND AGGREGATE BASES.

IATERIALS

FURNISH GEOGRID MEETING MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 304 OF THE CURRENT SPECIFICATIONS, TENSAR TX5 TRIAXIAL GEOGRID OR APPROVED EQUIVALENT. ANY ALTERNATE SUBMITTED BY THE CONTRACTOR FOR CONSIDERATION SHOULD INCLUDE DETAILED TESTING INFORMATION AND PERFORMANCE HISTORY. THE INFORMATION PROVIDED SHOULD INCLUDE THE IMPROVEMENT TO THE RESILIENT MODULUS OF THE AGGREGATE LAYER. ENSURE THAT EACH ROLL IS LABELED WITH THE MANUFACTURER'S NAME, PRODUCT TYPE, LOT NUMBER, ROLL NUMBER, MANUFACTURED DATE, AND ROLL DIMENSION.

CONSTRUCTION

- 1. GEOGRID REPRESENTATIVE. ENSURE THAT A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GEOGRID MANUFACTURER IS ON THE PROJECT WHEN WORK BEGINS, AND REMAINS ON CALL AS THE PROJECT PROGRESSES, TO ADVISE THE ENGINEER.
- 2. SURFACE PREPARATION. PREPARE THE SURFACE ACCORDING TO SECTION 207 AND SECTION 208.
- 3. GEOGRID PLACEMENT. PLACE GEOGRID AT THE PROPER ELEVATION AND ALIGNMENT, IN CONTINUOUS STRIPS WITH OVERLAPPING ACCORDING TO THE MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDATIONS. VERIFY THE GEOGRID ORIENTATION (ROLL DIRECTION). GEOGRID SHALL BE TEMPORARILY SECURED IN PLACE TO MAINTAIN TENSION DURING AGGREGATE PLACEMENT. THIS MAY BE DONE WITH STAPLES, PINS, SAND BAGS OR BACKFILL AS REQUIRED BY FILL PROPERTIES, FILL PLACEMENT PROCEDURES, OR WEATHER CONDITIONS AS THE ENGINEER DIRECTS.
- 4. AGGREGATE PLACEMENT. PLACE AGGREGATE OVER THE GEOGRID ACCORDING TO THE CONTRACT. PLACE, SPREAD, AND COMPACT THE AGGREGATE IN SUCH A MANNER THAT MINIMIZES THE DEVELOPMENT OF WRINKLES AND MOVEMENT IN THE GEOGRID. THE DEPARTMENT WILL REQUIRE A MINIMUM LOOSE FILL THICKNESS OF 6 INCHES PRIOR TO OPERATION OF TRACKED VEHICLES OVER THE GEOGRID. KEEP THE TURNING OF TRACKED VEHICLES TO A MINIMUM TO PREVENT DISPLACEMENT OF THE FILL AND DAMAGE TO THE GEOGRID. RUBBER TIRED EQUIPMENT MAY PASS OVER THE GEOGRID REINFORCEMENT AT SLOW SPEEDS (LESS THAN 10 MPH) WHEN INTEGRALLY-FORMED GEOGRID IS USED, AND THE SUBGRADE IS COMPETENT TO SUPPORT WHEEL LOADING WITHOUT DEFORMATION. AVOID SUDDEN BRAKING AND SHARP TURNING MOVEMENTS. REPAIR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED DURING PLACEMENT OR BY VEHICLES.

MEASUREMENT

THE DEPARTMENT WILL MEASURE THE QUANTITY OF GEOGRID IN SQUARE YARDS. THE DEPARTMENT WILL NOT MEASURE PROVIDING THE GEOGRID MANUFACTURER'S REPRESENTATIVE FOR PAYMENT AND WILL CONSIDER IT INCIDENTAL TO THE GEOGRID.

PAYMENT

THE CABINET WILL MAKE PAYMENT FOR THE COMPLETED AND ACCEPTED QUANTITIES UNDER THE FOLLOWING:

THE CABINET WILL CONSIDER PAYMENT AS FULL COMPENSATION FOR ALL WORK REQUIRED IN THIS NOTE.

TREE CUTTING RESTRICTIONS

CUTTING TREES IS PROHIBITED JUNE 1 THROUGH JULY 31. TREES ARE BEING CUT BY OTHERS PRIOR TO JUNE 1. HOWEVER, SHOULD ANY TREES REMAIN THAT NEED TO BE REMOVED AND ARE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT CUT JUNE 1 THROUGH JULY 31.

GENERAL NOTES

KENTUCKY ONE CALL

CALL KY811 AT 1–800–752–6007 TOLL FREE A MINIMUM OF TWO AND NO MORE THAN TEN BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO EXCAVATION FOR INFORMATION ON THE LOCATION OF EXISTING UNDERGROUND UTILITIES WHICH SUBSCRIBE TO THE KENTUCKY ONE CALL SERVICE. COORDINATE EXCAVATION WITH ALL UTILITY OWNERS, INCLUDING THOSE WHO DO NOT SUBSCRIBE TO KENTUCKY ONE CALL. ALL UTILITIES CAN BE FOUND ON SHEET NO. R3 OF THE PLANS.

STANDARD DRAWINGS

STANDARD DRAWINGS ARE NOT ATTACHED TO THESE PLANS. A STANDARD DRAWING BOOK AND THE HEADWALL SUPPLEMENTAL BOOK MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE POLICY SUPPORT BRANCH OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES IN FRANKFORT, KY AT (502) 564–3670.

CONTROL OF ACCESS

THE CONTROL OF ACCESS ON THIS PROJECT SHALL BE BY PERMIT ON GRADE LANE OUTSIDE THE INTERCHANGE AREA AND FULLY CONTROLLED ACCESS INSIDE THE INTERCHANGE AREA.

MARKING REMOVAL

REMOVAL OF THE EXISTING STRIPING WILL BE DONE BY WATER ABRASIVE BLASTING SO THE STRIPE IS NO LONGER VISIBLE ON THE PAVEMENT WITHOUT DAMAGING THE PAVEMENT. ANY DAMAGE TO THE PAVEMENT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR.

GUARDRAIL

ANY GUARDRAIL DAMAGED WILL BE REPAIRED WITHIN 5 DAYS AFTER BEING NOTIFIED BY THE ENGINEER.

RAFFIC SIGNAL(S)

THE CONTRACTOR WILL COORDINATE WITH LOUISVILLE METRO AND/OR THE ENGINEER 7 DAYS PRIOR TO ANY WORK TAKING PLACE THAT WILL INVOLVE TRAFFIC SIGNALS.

WATER TRANSMISSION LINE

PRIOR TO ANY WORK TAKING PLACE THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER AND LOUISVILLE WATER COMPANY 5 DAYS IN ADVANCE.

ANY DAMAGE TO THE WATER TRANSMISSION LINE AND ANY FURTHER DAMAGE CAUSED BY CONSTRUCTION TO ADJACENT FACILITIES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR.

GUARDRAIL END TREATMENT

CONTRARY TO KYTC STANDARD DRAWING RBR-020-05 THE GUARDRAIL END TREATMENT ET-PLUS MANUFACTURED BY TRINITY INDUSTRIES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED AS AN OPTION FOR BID ITEM *GUARDRAIL END TREATMENT TYPE 1*.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES NEAR AIRPORT

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES AND CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED SOUTH OF STA 13+19.36 UNLESS THE CONTRACTOR HAS OBTAINED A TEMPORARY PERMIT FOR CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FROM THE KENTUCKY AIRPORT ZONING COMMISSION (KAZC). THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS NEEDED FOR SUBMITTAL OF THE PERMIT:

- 1. CONTRACTOR NAME AND MAILING ADDRESS
- 2. LAT/LONG OF THE FOUR CORNERS OF THE AREA WHERE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WILL OCCUR
- 3. ELEVATIONS FOR EACH OF THE FOUR POINTS IN THE PREVIOUS STEP
 4. HEIGHT OF THE TALLEST PIECE OF EQUIPMENT OPERATING IN THE AREA DEFINED IN STEP 2 & 3
- 5. START AND END DATES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA DEFINED ABOVE

THE PERMIT IS GOOD FOR 4 MONTHS. IF A TIME EXTENSION IS NEEDED TO COMPLETE THE WORK IN THE AREA DEFINED ABOVE, THE CONTRACTOR MUST REQUEST A REISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT PRIOR TO THE ORIGINAL EXPIRING.

CONTRACTOR MUST EMAIL JOHN HOULIHAN AT THE ADDRESS ABOVE 5 DAYS PRIOR TO OPERATING EQUIPMENT IN THE AREA DEFINED ABOVE.
