

## Project Update

On November 13, 2013 the first public meeting for this project was held. Since then, field surveys, initial environmental analysis, traffic forecasts, and preliminary alternatives have been completed. Based on the public input received and the analyses conducted, the study area has been reduced to the northern half of the initial area.

Also, since the last meeting the Kentucky Legislature enacted a new *Six Year Highway Plan (2014-2020)*. The new plan includes funds for right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, and construction. The previous plan only had funds for the planning and design.

## Next Steps

Based on your input tonight, our project team will continue to study the **preliminary alignments** to extend Ring Road east to I-65 and US 31W. The studies will include **environmental analyses** of the human and natural environment, design issues, cost, and public input.
