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


US 60 Widening Project, KYTC Item No 04-394.00

The project is located in Irvington, KY. The design includes a center turn lane along US 60 from MP 28.7 to 29.6 and improving KY 79/KY 2202 from KY 2202 MP 3.2 to KY 79 MP 15.4 in support of the US 60 widening. The purpose of the project is to reduce congestion during peak periods and eliminate the "Y" intersection of KY 79 and US 60.

The meeting this evening provides property owners along the project with information about the right of way process that is now beginning. An informal format for this meeting means that there is no formal presentation, instead, information and personnel are available to answer questions that you may have about the project and how your property may be affected.

A comment form is available for your use in identifying information about your property that is inaccurate or has changed. We encourage you to complete and return your comment sheet this evening or return it by September 19, 2014 to our office at the address shown on the form.



Right of Way Process

- 1) Appraisal: Is an opinion of fair market value of each property before the acquisition and of the remaining property after the acquisition. The difference between these two values is the amount of compensation to be offered for the property being acquired.
- 2) Acquisition: Is the process in which an offer is made to purchase real property (real estate) or some interest therein based upon the appraisal. This offer is made by a right of way agent either in person or by mail, and the offer is discussed with the owner.
- 3) Relocation Assistance: Is a program provided to all individuals or businesses displaced by the project to locate and occupy a similar dwelling or business location. This ensures that persons displaced as a result of highway projects are treated fairly, consistently and equitably.
