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Closure scheduled for US 60 bridge in Clark County

US 60 overpass bridge over I-64 at Exit 101

LEXINGTON, Ky. (July 24, 2012) – The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways, announces that a temporary closure is scheduled for the US 60 overpass bridge located in Clark County. The closure is necessary for overlay work to be completed on the bridge. This is part of the ongoing rehabilitation project for Interstate 64 in Clark and Montgomery Counties.

Work will begin:

- Wednesday, July 25 – the bridge will close at 7:00 a.m. and remain closed until reopening on Tuesday, July 31 at 8:00 p.m.

The location of the bridge repair rehabilitation work on the US 60 overpass bridge will be over Interstate 64 at Exit 101 in Clark County. Appropriate signage is in place to guide the traveling public.

Alternate route:

- motorists are advised to use Interstate 64

All work is scheduled on a tentative basis and is subject to change depending on weather conditions, emergencies and other factors beyond the control of the Department of Highways.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet asks motorists to be aware of the work zone and to utilize safe driving habits when traveling near the work area.
