Shoulder closures scheduled for I-64 and I-75 in Fayette County

Lighting repair work to be completed for the barrier wall

LEXINGTON, Ky. (August 22, 2011) – The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways, announces that shoulder closures are scheduled for Interstate 64 and Interstate 75 in Fayette County. The closures are necessary for lighting repair work to be completed for the barrier wall.

Work will be performed during the following date and times:

- Tuesday, August 23 – work will begin at 9:00 a.m. and continue until 2:00 p.m.

The location of the work on I-64 and I-75 westbound will be between mile points 115.00 and 116.00. Repairs will take place on both the south and northbound inside shoulders.

Appropriate signage will be in place to the traveling public.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet asks motorists to be aware of the work zone and to utilize safe driving habits when traveling near the work area.
