### **US 68 project for Bourbon County to begin** *Road widening project will involve developing four lanes*

LEXINGTON, Ky. (February 7, 2012) — The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways, announces that construction work will begin Wednesday, February 8, for the US 68 project in Bourbon County.

The location for the work will be from the east edge (mile point 0.00) of the Paris By-Pass extending to and ending near Millersburg. The total project distance will be 6.392 miles. The roadway will be widened from the existing two lanes to four lanes.

Significant impacts to traffic will not be in effect for several months. Appropriate signage is in place to alert the traveling public of the road work. The anticipated completion date for the widening is April 22, 2014.

All scheduled work is subject to change depending on weather, emergencies and other factors beyond the control of the Department of Highways.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet asks motorists to be aware of the work zone and to utilize safe driving habits when traveling through the work area.
