

Compile Error when loading Spreadsheet

There have been sporadic reports of “Compile Errors” upon enabling the ActiveX and Macros when starting the Pavement Design spreadsheet (at least the newest version 5.05, Dec-12). A windows update is causing errors with ActiveX controls in Excel. Some old .exd files need to be deleted in the user’s temporary folder. Some of the files are as follows:

C:\Users\[user.name]\AppData\Local\Temp\Excel8.0\MSForms.exd

C:\Users\[user.name]\AppData\Local\Temp\VBE\MSForms.exd

C:\Users\[user.name]\AppData\Local\Temp\Word8.0\MSForms.exd

You can go to the C:\Users\[user.name]\AppData\Local\Temp and delete any Office temporary directories (Excel8.0, VBE, Word8.0, or similar), and delete those directories – close any office applications, FIRST, or you can do a “disc cleanup” as follows:

Close any open Office applications FIRST.

Click Start, point to All Programs, point to Accessories, point to System Tools, and then click Disk Cleanup.

Select the C: drive.

It will take a few moments to calculate disc space to clean.

Scroll down and make sure that "Temporary Files" is checked.

Click "OK."

It will ask, "Are you sure..."

Click "Delete Files."
