The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways has scheduled a public information meeting for Tuesday, June 12, 2012 from 5:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. at the Mayor's Office at the Russell City Building located at 410 Ferry Street, Russell, Kentucky. This Public Meeting has been scheduled to provide all interested persons an opportunity to become better informed and to express their views concerning the proposed project. The project is the proposed bridge replacement on KY 244 over CSX Railroad, 0.5 mile northeast of junction US 23.

During the meeting, individuals will be able to view displays and ask questions one on one with Department representatives. A questionnaire/comment sheet will be distributed facilitating public comment. Oral and written comments can be made during and after the meeting Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. until June 27, 2012 at the Department of Highways District 9 Office, located at 822 Elizaville Avenue, Flemingsburg, P. O. Box 347, Kentucky 41041. The materials present during the meeting will also be made available at that location during the same time period.

All oral and written comments will become part of the official meeting record. Once compiled, the meeting record and other supporting documentation will be made available for review and copying only after an Open Records Request has been received and approved. All Open Record Requests must be submitted to the Transportation Cabinet, Office of Legal Affairs, Transportation Office Building, 200 Mero Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40622.

Information concerning Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act will be available for anyone interested in signing up for this important process.
