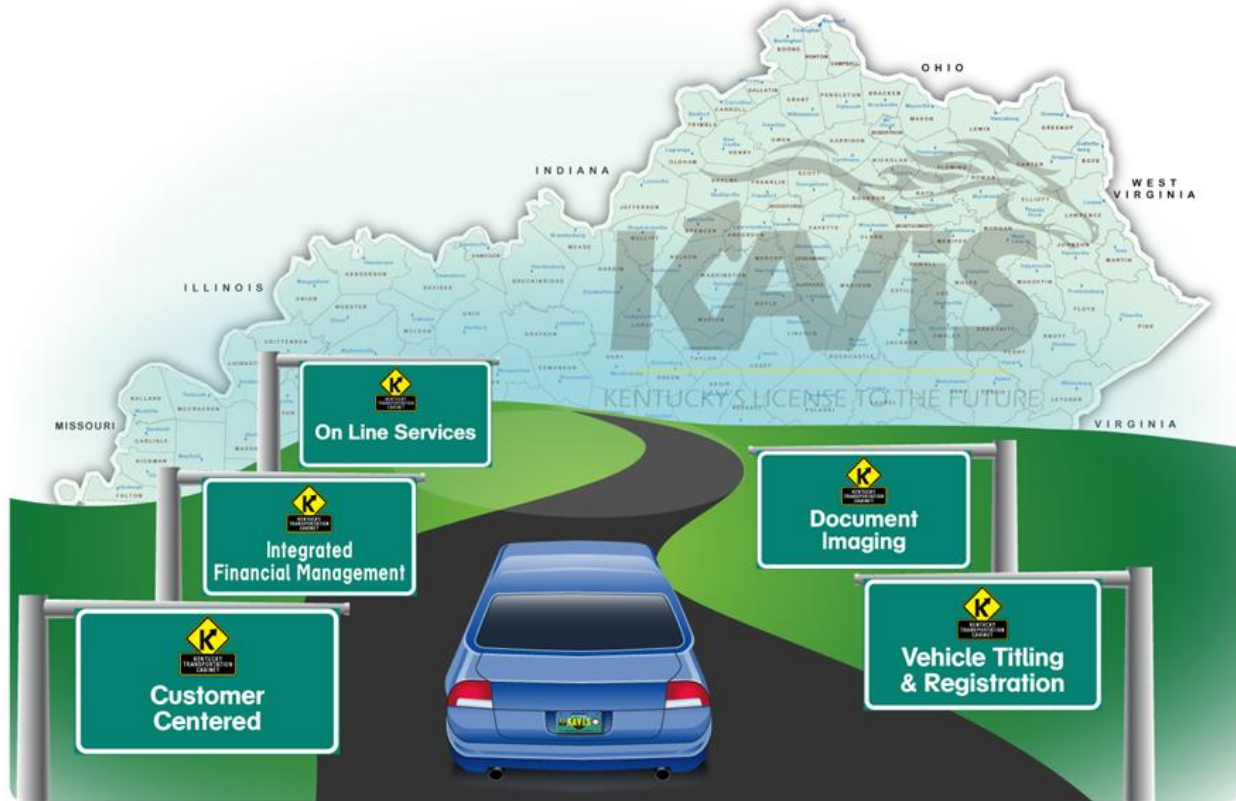

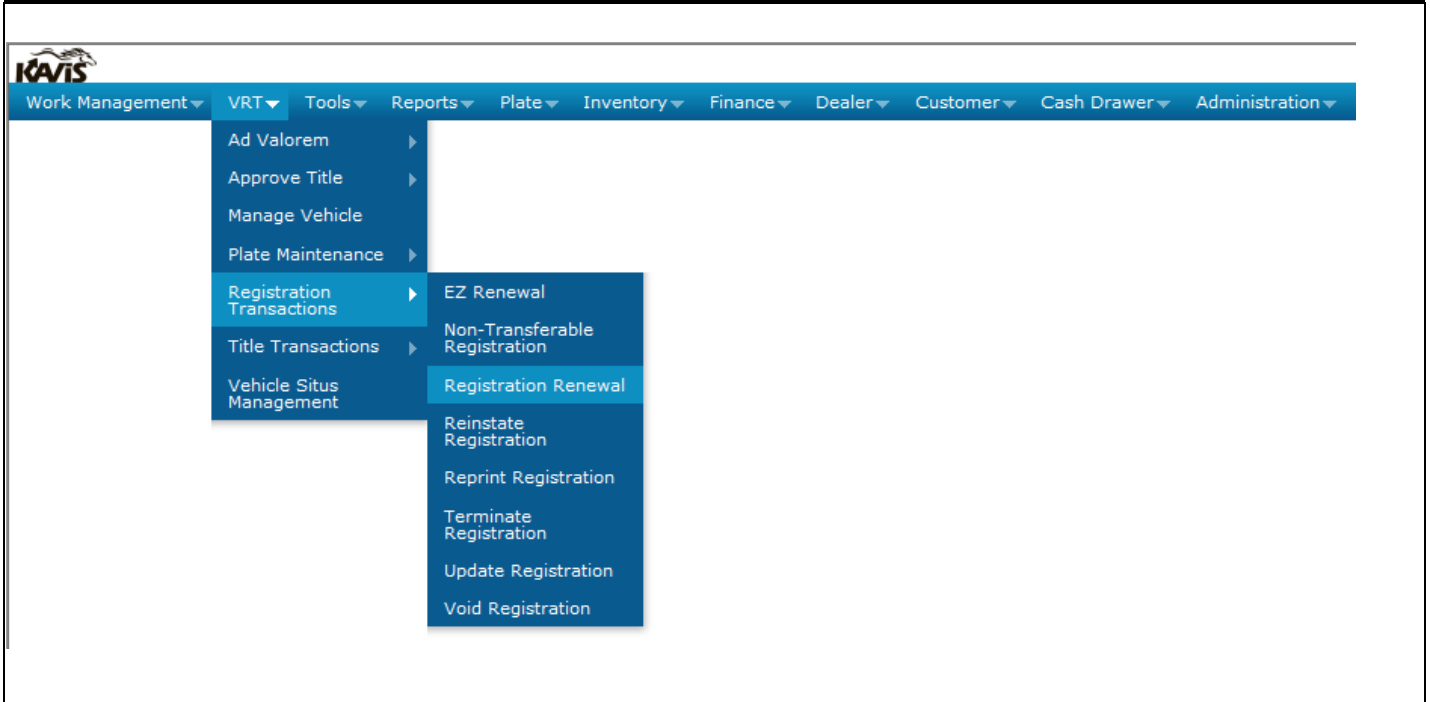

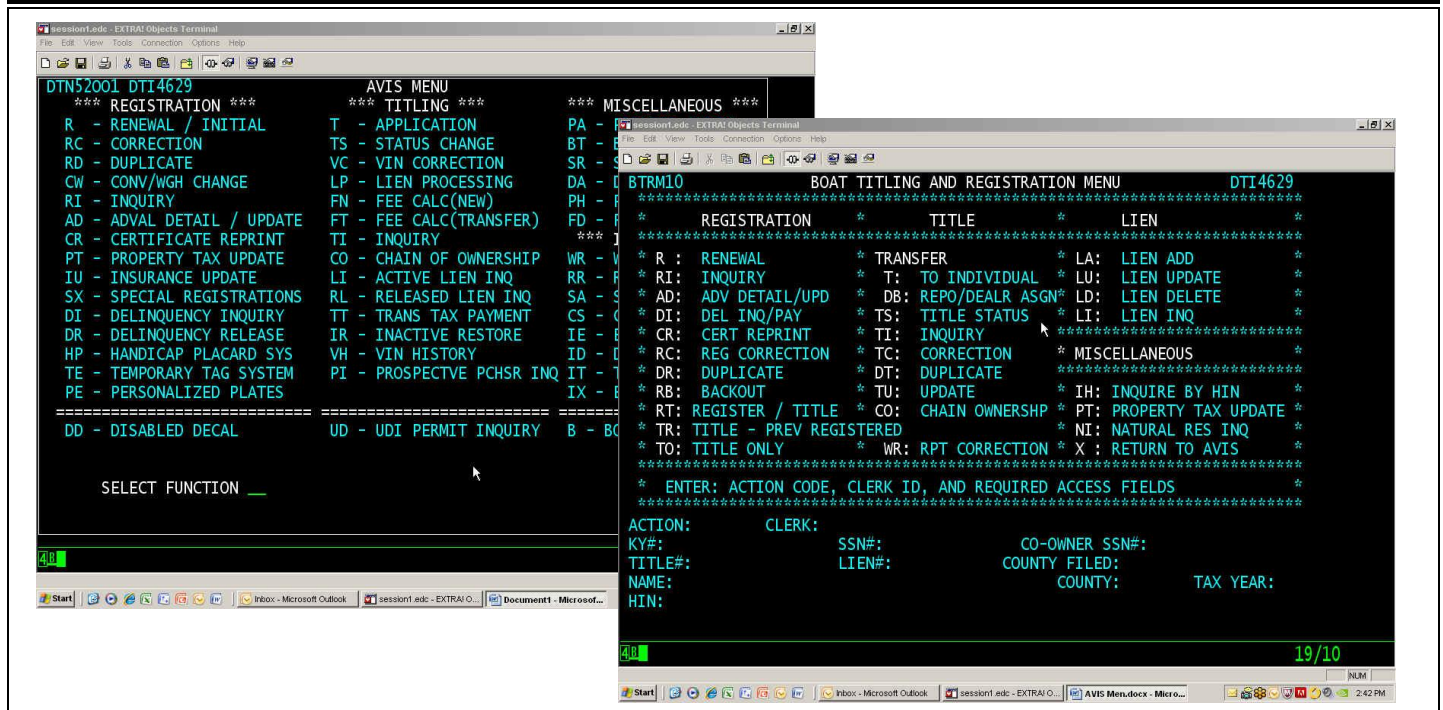

AVIS and BTR Used Non-Intuitive Menu Navigation





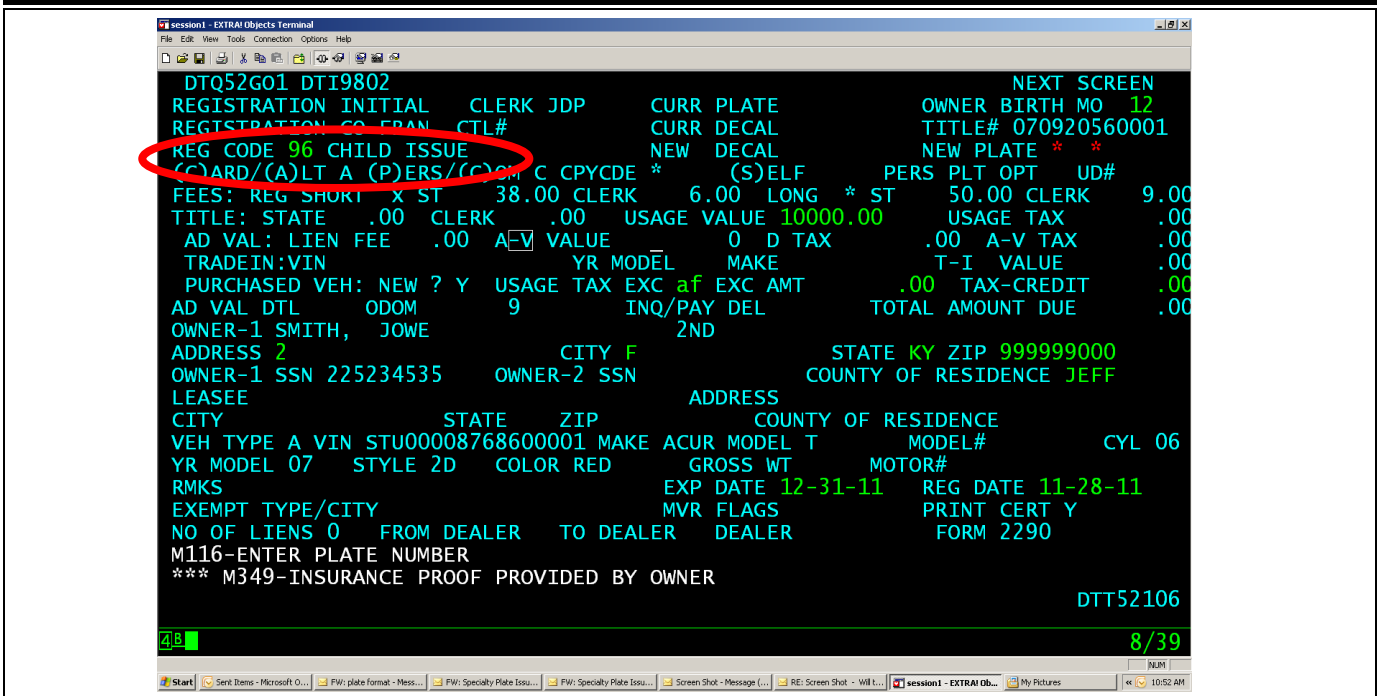

County Clerks' Frequently Asked Questions about KAVIS

What is KAVIS?

KAVIS stands for **K**entucky **A**utomated **V**ehicle **I**nformation **S**ystem. KAVIS will provide the Commonwealth with a flexible, customer-centered information system for vehicle and boat titling, registration, and financial management. The KAVIS comprehensive solution will replace our legacy systems – the Automated Vehicle Information System (AVIS) and the Boat Titling and Registration System (BTR).

When will KAVIS Go-Live?

The revised go-live date is the second quarter of 2013. The Kentucky County Clerk Association (KCCA) requested that the go-live date not be scheduled during the 2012 May primary or November general election cycles.

The revised go-live date is due to the level of change request activity on the project. Change requests on the KAVIS project have been issued to add functionality to meet existing Commonwealth statutes, to replace existing AVIS functionality, or to support business processes. KYTC and 3M KAVIS team members have analyzed existing pending change requests and determined that additional time is required to build the changes into the system. Every change that is made to the system will be thoroughly tested.

KYTC and 3M KAVIS team members continue to analyze pending change requests and once this analysis is completed, a firm go-live date will be established and communicated to everyone.

Moving the project go-live date out means that we are continuing to make progress and move toward go-live. However, because change requests add functionality to the system, additional test cycles must be scheduled and each new test cycle adds a month to the overall project schedule. User Acceptance Testing (UAT) will be scheduled once system testing is completed. UAT is the process where the Commonwealth will certify that the system is ready for go-live.

Train-the-Trainer Training (TTT) will be scheduled following UAT. End User Training will be scheduled at the end of TTT.

What do I need to be doing right now to prepare for KAVIS?

1. Be aware of the status of the project and be on the lookout for any offered training. For example, attend the KAVIS Test Drives offered during the Spring and Fall KCCA Conferences.
2. Check in frequently with KAVIS Konnection for updates and information on Organizational Change tools, Computer Based Training Modules, Training Materials, project schedule, etc.
3. Frequently check your KY.GOV email for KAVIS-related updates and information. Regularly checking your KY.GOV email is vital to your success with KAVIS.
4. Share KAVIS information with other members of your staff.
5. Be an enthusiastic Change Leader – this will help your team deal with the anxiety caused by change.
6. Talk to other counties about ways they are preparing for KAVIS. Sharing information with each other can benefit everyone.
