- **A VOIDED CHECK (OR A COPY OF A VOIDED CHECK) MUST ACCOMPANY THE COMPLETED FORM** above to authorize the debit of your account for payment of Overweight/Over-Dimensional Permits.
- Funds will be deducted within two business days after a permit has been issued.
- A brief explanation of the ACH debit process may be helpful to you. When you use a check to pay for something, your banks transit number and your account number (both of which are preprinted at the bottom of your check) tell which bank and account number your money is in so that the bank can transfer the money into our account. This process allows us to keep these two numbers on file for you and process the transfer of money when you have obtained permits.
- This process eliminates the need for you to fill out a check and deliver it to us. It eliminates the need for us to process your check and prepare a deposit slip for our bank. Finally, it eliminates the need for either of our banks to process your check. Your bank statement will actually show that the amount deducted was transferred to The Commonwealth of Kentucky and was for your payment for permits.
- While you already provide us with this information every time you send us your check, this information will be kept in a secured location. Any changes to your bank account number must be done in writing and will not be accessible through our normal call-in procedures.
