## New Madrid Seismic Zone

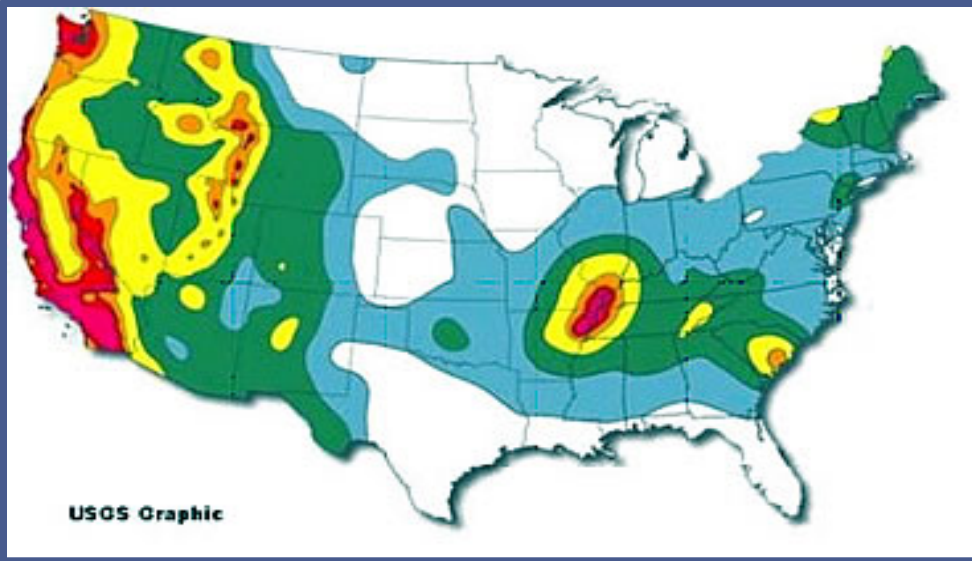
- Earthquake activity threatens parts of eight American states: Alabama, Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, **Kentucky**, Mississippi, Missouri, and Tennessee
- The New Madrid fault is active. It averages more than 200 measured events (1.0 or more on the Richter scale) per year.
- Tremors large enough to be felt (2.5 - 3.0 on the Richter scale) are noted annually.
- Every 18 months the fault releases a shock of 4.0 or more, capable of local minor damage.
- 24 counties in Kentucky would be impacted if a tremor occurs

# New Madrid Seismic Zone



## DAMAGING EARTHQUAKE

(6.0 or greater) occurs about every 80 years.

- The last one was October 31, 1895.
- 90% chance of occurrence by 2040.

## MAJOR EARTHQUAKE

(7.5 or greater), occurs every 200- 300 years .

- The last one in 1812.
- 10% chance in the next 50 years.

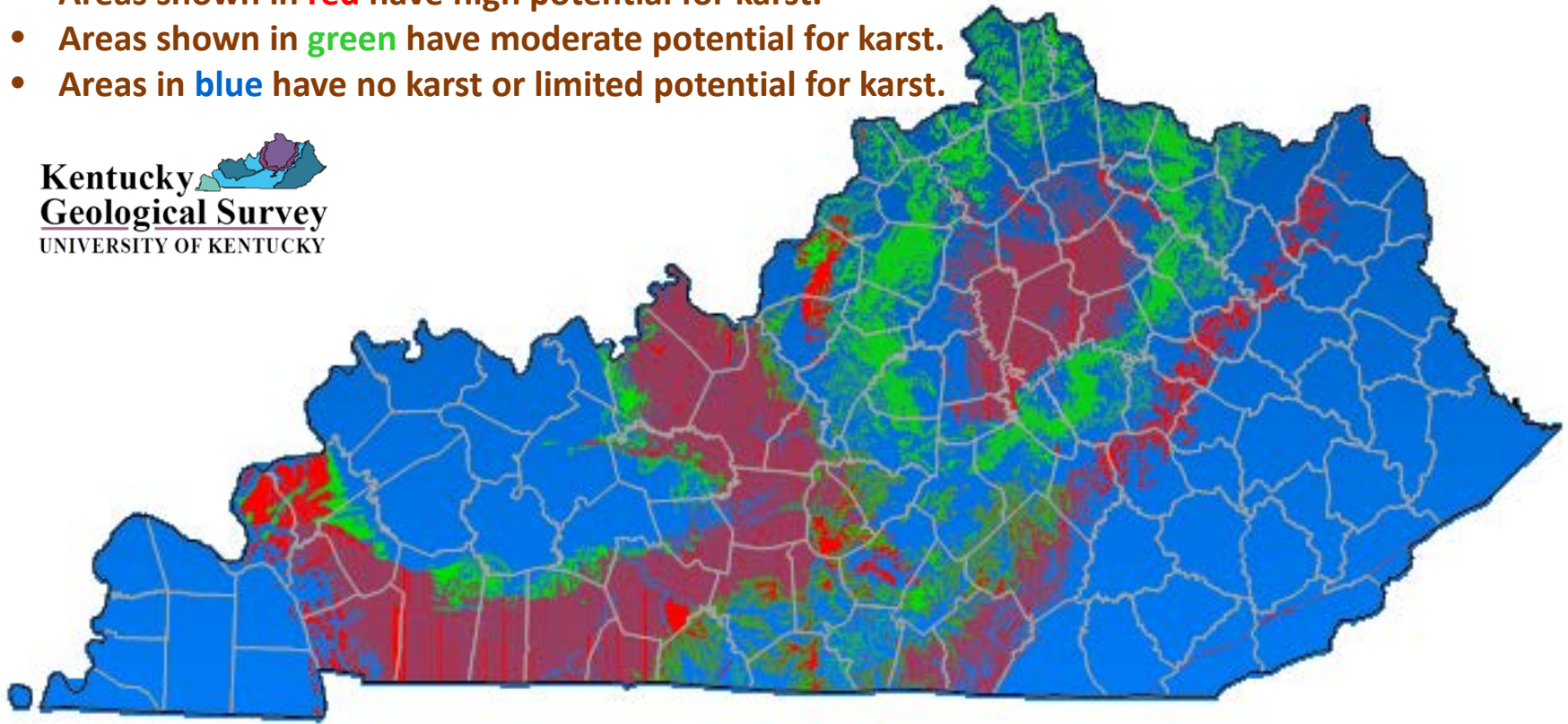

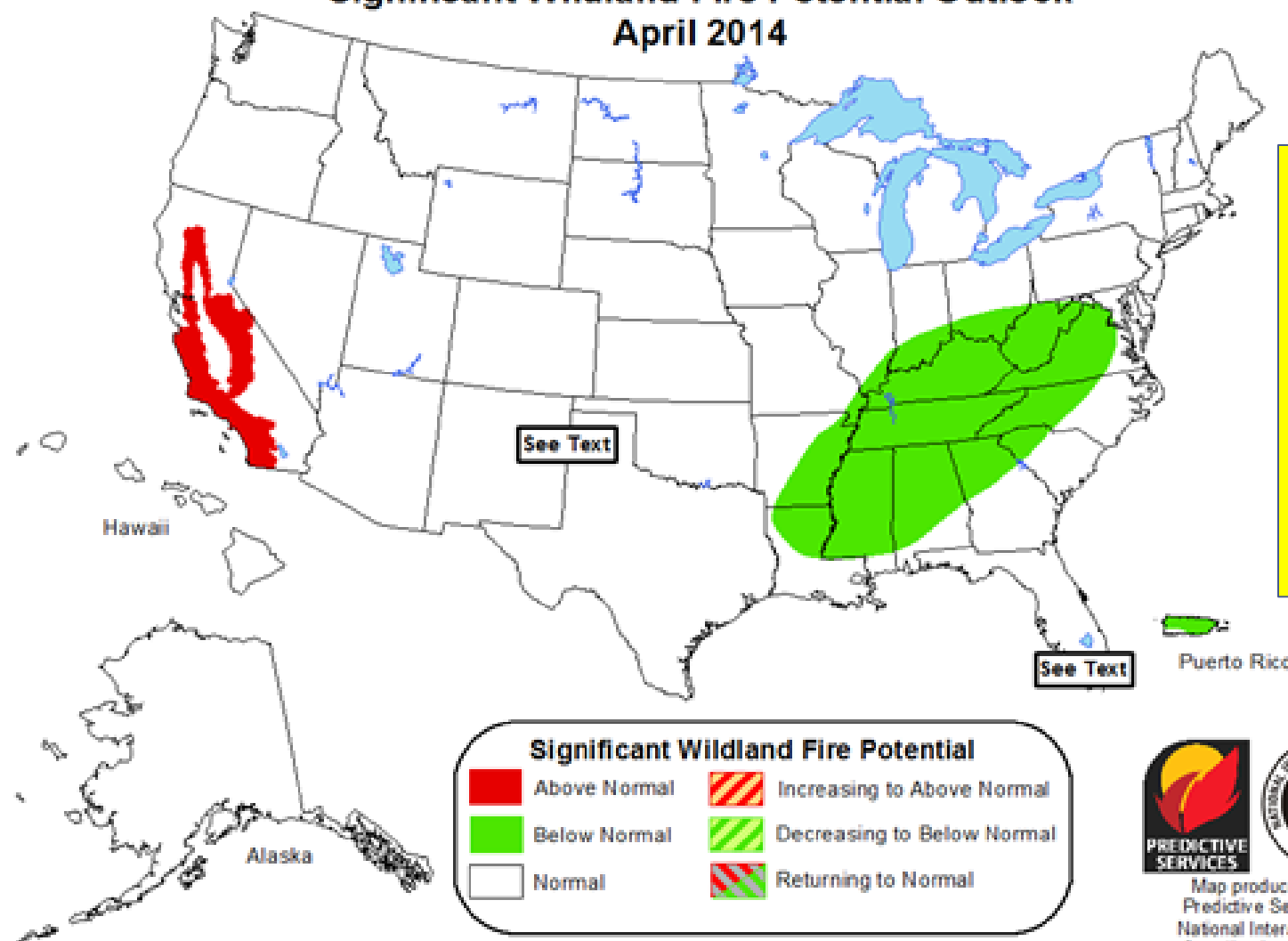

## Significant Wildland Fire Potential Outlook April 2014



### April

- Above normal significant fire potential will continue over the southern California mountains and foothills and will begin to return across portions of central and northern California.
- Most of the southeastern U.S. will remain in below normal significant fire potential.
- Localized short-term above normal significant fire potential may be observed in eastern New Mexico and west Texas as well as southern Florida.

Above normal significant wildland fire potential indicates a higher than usual likelihood that wildland fires will occur and/or become significant events. Wildland fires are still expected to occur during forecasted normal conditions as would usually be expected during the outlook period. Significant wildland fires are still possible but less likely than usual during forecasted below normal periods.

### Flood Inundation Maps for Frankfort and Hopkinsville

The **National Weather Service** (NWS) in corporation with the **US Army Corp of Engineers** (USACE), the **United States Geological Survey** (USGS), and the **City of Frankfort** have developed a series of maps showing what sections of Frankfort can expect flooding at various stages.

The maps run from 27 feet (4 feet below flood stage) up to 52 feet (3.5 feet above the record crest of 1978). For each foot within this range, maps show the area extent of flooding and the estimated depth.
