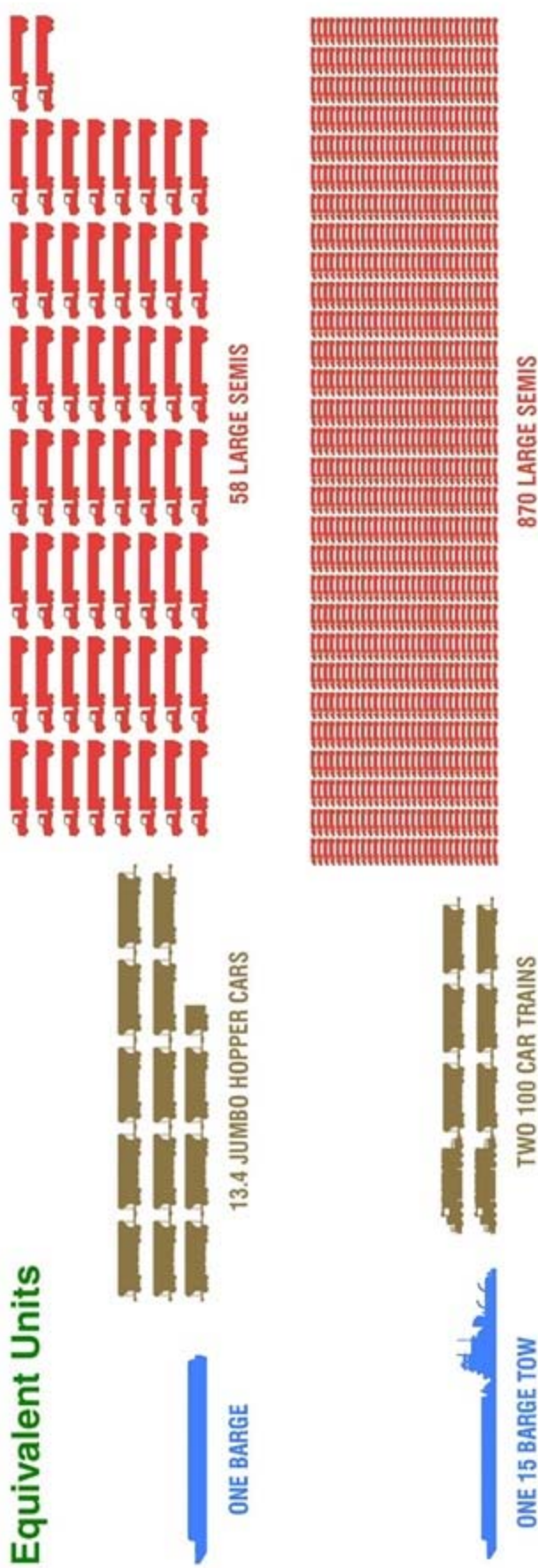

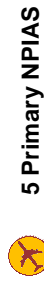
National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS):

5 Primary NPIAS

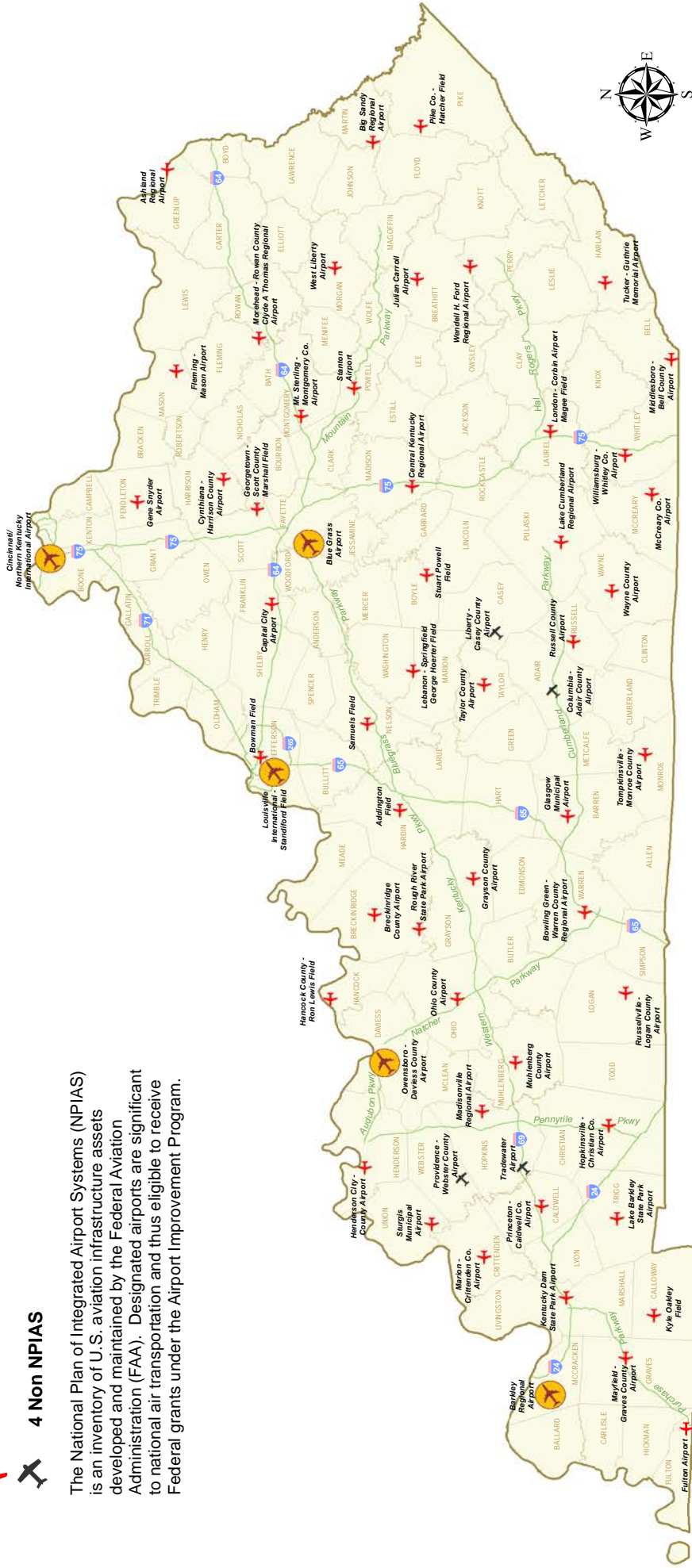

In compliance with the Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982 (STAA) and DOT Appropriations Act of 1983 and KRS 189.222, Kentucky has established a network of highways on which motor vehicles with increased dimensions (STAA vehicles) may operate.

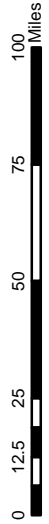
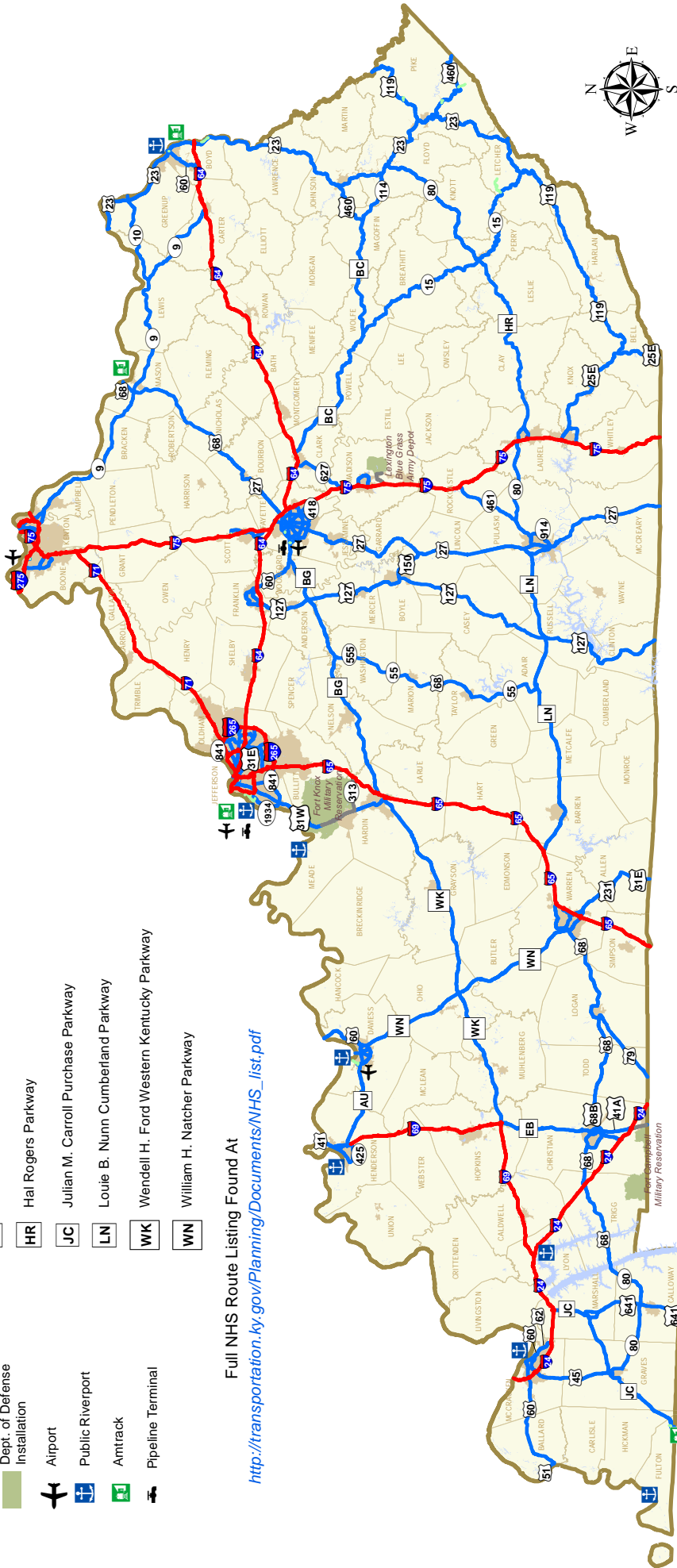
Motor vehicles with these increased dimensions shall be allowed on state-maintained highways five (5) driving miles from the designated system and fifteen (15) miles from an interstate or parkway exit for the purpose of attaining reasonable access to terminals, facilities for food, fuel, repairs, or rest. The allowed access is reduced to one (1) driving mile from the designated system on public use highways which are not state-maintained.

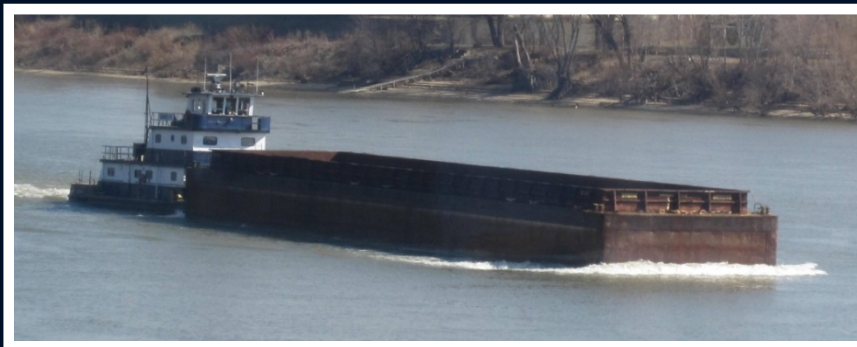

Kentucky is located in the Eighth District. The office is located in New Orleans and covers all or part of 26 states. The Eighth District is vital in protecting the 900 miles of coastline and 10,300 miles of inland navigable waterways located in its area of responsibility. Protecting America's borders is the key to ensuring the free flow of commerce and the safety of its citizens.

USCG Eight District:

- 2 of the nation's busiest ports: New Orleans and Houston.
- 2 M+ barrels of oil and 1 M+ tons of cargo are imported daily into the district.
- 17 of the top 40 ports by tonnage are located in the district.
- 65+% of the nation's Liquefied Natural Gas activity and 11% of Crude Oil Refining capacity are located in the Port Arthur, TX / Lake Charles, LA region alone.

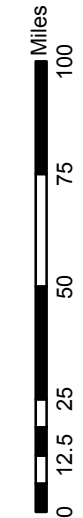
