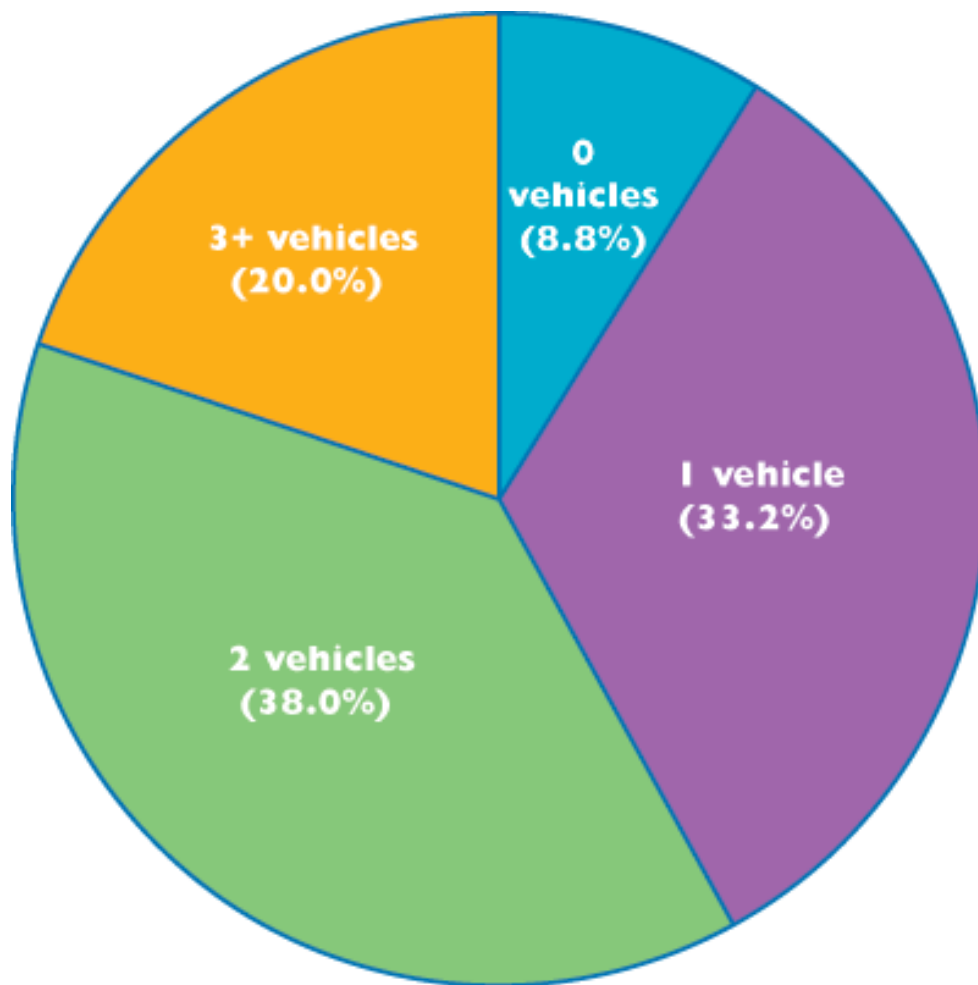
1907

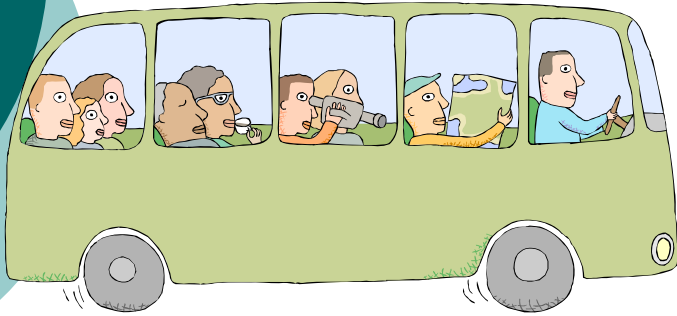

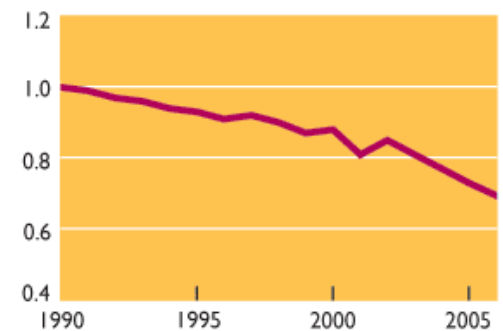

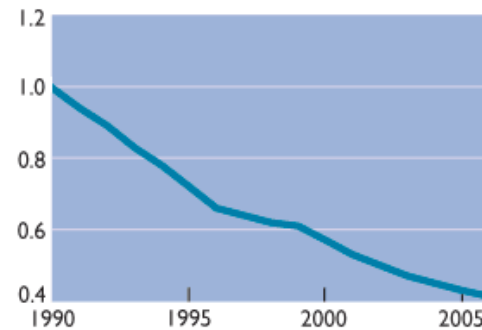
Carbon monoxide



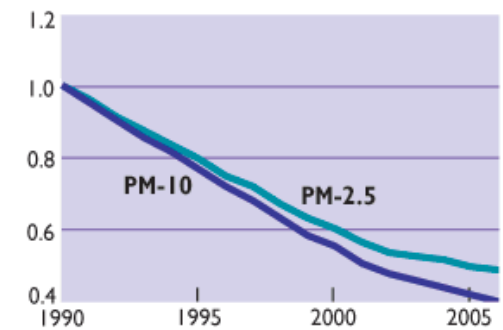
Nitrogen oxides



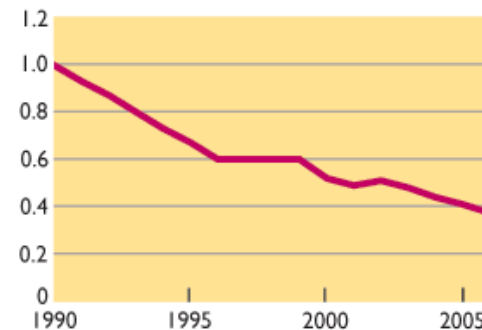
Volatile organic compounds



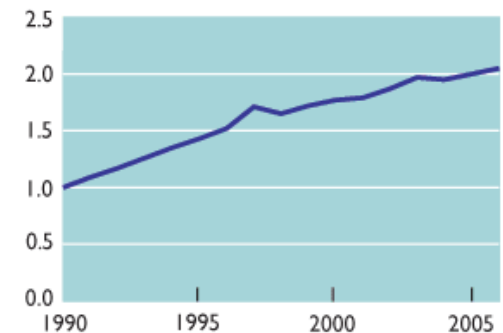
PM-10; PM-2.5
