SUBJECT: Notification of Administrative Modification #39 to the FY 2021 - FY 2024 Transportation

Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #57 to the 2045

Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On October 4, 2023, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #39 to the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP and Modification #57 to the 2045 MTP.

Administrative Modification #39:

This action updates the previously published documents and tables. The modification adds supplementary funding¹ to an existing grouped project² (Bike/Ped Facilities) which does not impact the financial constraint of the TIP.

Mt Tabor Multimodal Improvements:

This modification adds \$100,000 (\$80,000 in Federal STBG-SLX (80%) + \$20,000 Local Match (20%)) to the construction phase to cover a change order for material cost increases, storm drainage modifications, and an additional retaining wall.

¹ Under the **Project Selection Process for Sub-Allocated Funding** adopted by the TPC on June 28, 2023 (Resolution 2023-13), certain requests for supplementary project funding only require LAMPO staff approval and an informal report to the TPC, provided they meet the following criteria: 1) The project has previously been awarded federal funds, 2) The request does not exceed \$250,000 and is less than 50% of the original project award, 3) The requesting agency is able to provide the required local match (usually 20%) for the increase, and 4) LAMPO staff have not previously awarded sub-allocated funding administratively to this project.

² The identification of Grouped Projects involves a commitment of additional funding by the project sponsor. The additional funding maintains financial constraint of these documents. A listing of Grouped Projects has been included in the TIP allowing planning process stakeholders and the general public to be informed of the types of potential projects that may be added to the TIP by Administrative Modification. TIP actions for these projects will not require additional public review, demonstration of fiscal constraint, or a conformity determination (if applicable).
