INTRODUCTION

The Kentucky State Management Plan (SMP) is a document that describes the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Office of Transportation Delivery's (OTD) policies and procedures for administering the State-managed portions of the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) §5309 §5310, §5311, §5311(b)(3), §5311(f), ~~§5316, §5317~~, §5305 ~~and~~ §5307 **and 5339** programs, where applicable. State requirements in the SMP may be more restrictive, but not less restrictive than Federal requirements. If any portion or requirements of the SMP inadvertently appears to be less restrictive than Federal requirements or regulations, Federal Transit Administration rules still apply. Even when not stated, "as amended" in the SMP when referring to Federal Transit Administration Circulars, Federal regulations or law, or Federal guidance, the most recent version of the document will apply.

Stakeholders may, in writing, comment on the proposed SMP, as well as any given time on the Final FTA approved SMP. However, once FTA approves the SMP, hard copies of the final document will be distributed to transit agencies and at any other stakeholder's request. The approved SMP shall also be posted as Final on the Kentucky Transit Association ("KPTA") website www.kypublictransit.org as well as the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Office of Transportation Delivery website. <http://transportation.ky.gov/Transportation-Delivery/Pages/default.aspx>

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The SMP is submitted to FTA for approval in an electronic format.
