ACTION: The Owensboro-Daviess County Metropolitan Planning Organization hereby modifies the FY 2019-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This modification reflects a change in the funding for the project from SPP (State Project, High Priority) and SB2 (State Bonds 2010) to STP (Surface Transportation Block Grant Program) for Design, Right-of-Way, Utility and Construction phases. Because of this change in funding, the project is moving from the TIP's Informational Supplement to Table 5, "Federally Funded Projects." The Design and Right-of-Way phases have been included in the current TIP tables. The Utility and Construction phases have been added to Table 13 of the TIP – "Federally Funded Project Phases Outside the Scope of the FY 2019-2024 TIP."

OTHER INFORMATION: This project is a project type identified in the Grouped Projects table of the TIP; therefore, a TIP Amendment is not necessary. A listing of Grouped Projects has been included in the TIP, allowing planning process stakeholders and the general public to be informed of the types of potential projects that may be added to the TIP and the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) by Administrative Modification. TIP actions for these types of projects will not require additional public review. The addition of specific projects from the Grouped Projects table involves an additional commitment of funding for the projects by the project sponsor (Kentucky Transportation Cabinet). The additional funding maintains the fiscal constraint of the TIP and MTP documents and no additional financial constrain analysis by the MPO is needed.
