Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On July 26, 2023, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #36 to the FY 2021 – 2024 TIP and Modification #54 to the 2045 MTP.

Administrative Modification #36:

This action updates the previously published documents and tables. The modification adds one new project and updates one existing project. Both are Grouped Projects* (Ferry Boat Capital and Operating Assistance and Bike/ped facilities) which do not impact the financial constraint of the TIP:

Valley View Ferry - Drydock Restoration & Preservation Project:

Federal Ferry Boat funds: \$240,000.00 (local matching funds (Fayette County): \$60,000)

Armstrong Mill Bike/Ped Improvements:

This modification moves \$20,000 (\$16,000 STBG-SLX + \$4,000 Local Match) from the Construction phase to the Design phase to cover the cost of a required archeological study.

* The identification of Grouped Projects involves a commitment of additional funding by the project sponsor. The additional funding maintains financial constraint of these documents. A listing of Grouped Projects has been included in the TIP allowing planning process stakeholders and the general public to be informed of the types of potential projects that may be added to the TIP by Administrative Modification. TIP actions for these projects will not require additional public review, demonstration of fiscal constraint, or a conformity determination (if applicable).
