SCOPE

The department will complete Phase I Design and will provide all applicable microstation (*.dgn) files and Inroads files used in the development of Phase I Design.

The selected Consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Phase II Roadway design, including drainage design, right of way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans and cost estimates.

The environmental document at this time is expected to be Categorical Exclusion Level 3 and will be prepared by the department staff. The department will also provide baseline data for any waste sites that are identified by the project team.

The Consultant will be responsible for compiling all of the necessary information to submit permit applications for all identified waste sites.

ENVIRONMENTAL

Department will pursue CE LVL 3 for the roadway. Consultant will be responsible for preparing the permit application for waste sites and developing stream mitigation plans.

KYTC will furnish manuscripts on computer disks in DGN format.

STRUCTURE DESIGN

The selected consultant shall do the necessary engineering services to submit to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet an Advance Situation folder(s) for the appropriate applicable structure(s). Upon submission of the folder(s), a determination will be made whether the structure design will be performed by the Department or by the consultant. Pre-qualification in the area of structure design is required to be identified in the consultant's Response to Announcement.
