<b>PURPOSE AND NEED</b>	<i>To improve the geometric deficiencies, traffic level of services, system linkage, and emergency vehicle response times, and add capacity for future traffic demands within the project area.</i>
<b>PROJECT LENGTH</b>	<i>Approximately 8 miles</i>
<b>METHOD OF DESIGN</b>	<i>The selected consultant shall utilize the CADD Standards for Highway Plans (version 2.0) policy in the development of the Highway Plans.</i>
<b>DBE REQUIREMENT</b>	<i>The Consultant team shall include a DBE Participation Plan with their response to announcement. An additional page will be allowed with the project approach in the response to announcement to convey this plan. A maximum of 4 points will be considered in the evaluation factors for the DBE Participation Plan.</i>

<b>SCOPE</b>	<p>The selected consultant will be required to provide engineering services for Phase II roadway design, including the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans and cost estimates.</p>
