PURPOSE AND NEED	<i>To provide an alternative north-south travel route, enhance system connectivity, implement a regional transportation priority, relieve traffic congestion and provide a facility that serves the planned growth in the project area.</i>

METHOD OF DESIGN	<i>The selected consultant shall utilize the CADD Standards for Highway Plans policy in the development of the Highway Plans.</i>
DBE REQUIREMENT	<i>None</i>

SCOPE	<p>The selected consultant will be required to provide Phase II (final roadway) design engineering services for three construction sections between Ring Road and KY 313 of the Elizabethtown to Radcliff Connector project. This includes the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans and cost estimates.</p>
