SCOPE	<i>The selected consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Phase I and Phase II roadway design for the reconstruction/relocation of US 641. This shall include the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right-of way and utility plans, traffic control, erosion control, Advance Situation Folders, Corps of Engineers permits and drawings, preliminary and final roadway construction plans with construction cost estimates. Phase II units will be negotiated after completion of Phase I.</i>


