## SCOPE OF WORK

Two consultants will be selected to provide airport planning and airport engineering services at any location within the Commonwealth on an as-needed basis in the following areas:

- General airport planning consultation (airport geometry, building configuration, aircraft/ automobile parking layout, etc.)
- Airport Layout Plans
- Airport Master Plans
- All other airport planning documents required by the FAA or KDA.
- General airport surveying/mapping (horizontal and vertical).
- Airport approach analysis/evaluation.
- Airport improvement design projects.
- Airport Construction Administration/Observation services.
- Airport Construction project estimates.

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Contracts will have an upset limit of \$500,000.00 per consultant. Once the upset limit is reached or the two year term has expired, services will be re-advertised and no additional work assignments will be made under the contract. Contracts will not be modified to increase upset limit or extended for time to assign new work. Projects to be assigned on a rotating basis by letters of agreement. No letter of agreement shall exceed \$100,000.
