PURPOSE AND NEED	This project is located within the City Limits of Beattyville and the purpose is to accommodate the existing pedestrian traffic and improve safety for pedestrian traffic and to improve roadway drainage along KY 52 mile post 11.7 to 12.20. The existing drainage consists of eroded open ditches located adjacent to the roadway that varies in depth along with undersized storm sewer systems along the project limits.
DBE REQUIREMENT	None
METHOD OF DESIGN	The Selected Consultant shall utilize the CADD Standards for Highway Plans (version 2.0) policy in the development of the Highway Plans.

SCOPE OF WORK

Conduct preliminary engineering studies applying practical solutions to identify appropriate typical section, line and grade, dependable cost estimate, and provide the necessary information needed for the Department to prepare an appropriate environmental document. The environmental document at this time is expected to be CE.

The Selected Consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Phase I and II Roadway Design; including drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans and cost estimates.

The purpose of the Design Contract is to provide Phase I Preliminary Engineering Services and Phase II Final Roadway Design.
