2018-09 – Bridge Program General Engineering Consultant

QUESTION: Does this mean that bridge design projects are anticipated to be part of future bulletins? If so, will these be traditional Design–Build or Design–Build projects? Are there an anticipated number of projects that will be available to the remaining consultant industry either outside the Bridge Program or thru the Program?

ANSWER: There may be bridge projects that are excluded from the bridge program that could be a part of future professional service advertisements. Projects in the bridge program will not be a part of future professional service advertisements but some may be delivered via design build contracting methods providing design firms additional opportunities.

QUESTION: Since a Utility Manager is required, is it an oversight that Utility Preconstruction Coordination is not one of the prequalification requirements?

ANSWER: The Utility Design prequalification requirements are all new and many firms have yet to have an opportunity to submit for or receive approval of these services. As a result, no utility design qualifications will be required with the initial response to advertisement; however, the selected consultant shall obtain necessary qualifications through the delivery of the program.
