II. PROJECT INFORMATION

III. PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this project is to improve the roadway typical section, vertical and horizontal geometry, drainage, and roadside clear zone for motorist's safety.

IV. DBE REQUIREMENT

The Consultant team shall include a DBE Participation Plan with their Response to Announcement to help the Department meet the 11.95% DBE goal established by FHWA. The plan needs to demonstrate how DBE companies will be mentored or used to assist in the area(s) pertaining to this contract. An additional page will be allowed in the Project Approach (Page 7) to demonstrate this plan. A maximum of 4 points will be considered in the Evaluation Factors for the DBE Participation Plan.

V. SCOPE OF WORK

The selected Consultant will be responsible for finalizing the Preliminary Engineering decisions including reviewing the alignment and project impacts. The selected Consultant will also be required to provide engineering services to perform Final Engineering Roadway Design, including the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right-of-way plans, structural design, construction plans, traffic control plans, and cost estimates.
