Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Administrative Modification #13 to

the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

On June 23, 2020, the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization issued Administrative Modification #30 to the FY 2017 – 2020 TIP and Modification #13 to the 2045 MTP.

Administrative Modification #30:

This action updates the previously published TIP document and tables. These modifications are considered Grouped Projects* (HSIP - Low Cost Safety Improvements & HSIP - High Cost Safety Improvements) which do not impact the financial constraint of the TIP. This modification adds the following 7 new projects:

- Upgrade the Traffic Signal to Include Reflective Backplates and Supplemental Signal Heads and Install Lane Separator Curb at the Intersection of US 27 & US 68 - \$50K FED
- Upgrade the Traffic Signal to include Reflective Backplates and Install Lane Separator Curb along Russell Cave Rd near the Intersection of Russell Cave Rd & New Circle Rd - \$60K FED
- Install Lane Separator Curb along Alexandria Dr near the Intersection of US 60 & Alexandria Dr \$35K FED
- Upgrade the Traffic Signal to include Reflective Backplates and Install Lane Separator Curb near the Intersection of New Circle Rd & Eastland Parkway - \$70K FED
- Upgrade the Traffic Signal to include Reflective Backplates and Install Lane Separator Curb near the Intersection of US 60
 & S Forbes Rd \$30K FED
- Upgrade the Traffic Signals along US 27 to include Reflective Backplates and Improve Access Control near the Intersection
 of US 27 & Haggard Ln \$54K FED + \$6K STATE = \$60K
- Construct Offset Left Turn Lanes along US 27, Upgrade the Traffic Signal to include Reflective Backplates, and Improve the Striping along Edgewood Dr near the Intersection of US 27 & Edgewood Dr (Jessamine Co) - \$117K FED +\$13K = \$130K
- * The identification of Grouped Projects involves a commitment of additional funding by the project sponsor. The additional funding maintains financial constraint of these documents. A listing of Grouped Projects has been included in the TIP allowing planning process stakeholders and the general public to be informed of the types of potential projects that may be added to the TIP by Administrative Modification. TIP actions for these projects will not require additional public review, demonstration of fiscal constraint, or a conformity determination (if applicable).
