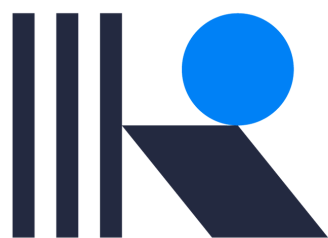
This modification to the STIP will become part of the 2021 STIP end of Federal Fiscal Year 2022 "fiscal constraint" recalculations.

Purpose & Need:	The purpose of this project is to reduce future traffic congestion at the I-65/KY 480 (Cedar Grove Road) interchange to acceptable levels of service (i.e., A, B, C, or D) and to improve access to existing and committed businesses in the Cedar Grove Business Park and surrounding area. The I-65/KY 480 southbound ramps' signalized intersection west of I-65 operates at LOS C during the AM peak travel period and LOS D during the peak PM travel period. In the 2040 design year, it is projected to operate at LOS D during the AM peak and LOS F during the PM peak, assuming that no improvements are made to the interchange. For the I-65/KY 480 northbound ramps' signalized intersection east of I-65, the 2015 AM and PM LOS of B will decline in operational performance to LOS E for the AM peak and LOS F for the PM peak in the 2040 design year.
