Theme – Adopt-a-Highway: Keep Kentucky Clean

5-8 Year Old Division

Theme:

- Portrays the theme and uses the words “Adopt-a-Highway” and/or “Keep Kentucky Clean”
- Includes image of roads or highways

Artistic Ability:

- Creates a neat and clean piece with recognizable subjects (not scribbles)
- Stays within the lines of the shapes/figures created
- Uses the entire canvas/poster/sheet of paper
- Level of skill demonstrated
- Free of spelling and grammar errors

Outreach:

- Educate the viewer about the harms of littering and the importance of a litter-free environment

9-11 Year Old Division:

Theme:
