Introduction

The pre-bid meeting was opened with a brief overview of the project team and schedule.

- 1. This pre-bid meeting is for the Cumberland County and Boyd County Bridge Cleaning and Painting Projects. Attendance at this virtual meeting is required in order to be eligible to submit a bid on the project.
- 2. The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the project and provide an opportunity for the contractors to pose questions.

Meeting Presentation

Tom Mathews (KYTC) presented an overview of the project repairs using a PowerPoint presentation.

Question & Answers

- 1. Byron Ogger and Nomiki Zembillas:
 - Question: Will the slide presentation be made available to bidders?
 - Answer: The PowerPoint presentation will be uploaded on the KYTC Contract Procurement website under Project Related Information. The PowerPoint presentation should not be considered part of the Contract Documents and should be used for information purposes only
- 2. Brad Wilder:
 - Question: Do we paint the support brackets for the utility on the US 60 Bridge? (202958 Boyd County).

Answer: The bracket attached to the girder will be cleaned and painted. The pipe hanger will not be cleaned and painted. The Contractor will take all measures to protect the pipe hangers and utility attached.

3. Jim Klimis:

Question: Will the square footage for each bridge be provided?

Answer: The square footage will be posted under the KYTC Contract Procurement website under Project Related Information. The square footage posted should not be considered part of the Contract Documents and should be used for information purposed only.

4. Brad Wilder:

Question: Is all the new steel on the Cumberland bridges from last year's project to be blasted and painted? The KY 90 bridge has a new stringer and floor beam cantilever. (202953 Cumberland County)

Answer: All structural steel will be cleaned and painted.

5. Brad Wilder:

Question: Can we close the sidewalk on the KY 90 bridge? (202953 Cumberland County)

Answer: Yes, the sidewalk can be closed.

6. Byron Ogger:

Question: It is imperative that any periods that we cannot have closures be clearly identified prior to Bid? (202953 Cumberland County)

Answer: A list of tentative times will be posted under KYTC Contract Procurement website under Project Related Information. These may vary. The department will coordinate with the USACE and the Contractor if these dates will vary. There will be a week notice for the closures.

7. Brad Wilder:

Question: Are we able to use all the existing access points through the flood wall or over the levee? It appears that some of these locations require crossing private property to access. (202958 Boyd County)

Answer: The Contractor will be responsible for obtaining any private property to access areas the inside the flood wall.

All public property can be used for access.

8. Brad Wilder:

Question: Is the US 60 side walk to remain open? (202958 Boyd County)

Answer: Yes, the side walk will remain open.

9. Jim Klimis:

Question: Will tool cleaning be permitted on the wood catwalk (202953 Cumberland County)

Answer: Yes, tool cleaning will be permitted for this.

10. Mary Joe Tirikos:

Question: Clarify the protection of the wood catwalk? (202953 Cumberland County).

Answer: The Contractor shall take necessary measures to protect the wood portion of the catwalk from any damage from cleaning and painting operations. Overspray will not be considered as a damage.

Sidewalk fencing will not be cleaned and painted (202958 Boyd County)

11. Garry Manous:

Question: Does all steel grit and disposable material go the recycling company.

Answer: Just any unusable steel grit and all disposable material will go to the recycling company.

12. Manuel Gialousis:

Question: If the structure is briefly closed to traffic to move equipment that exceeds the weight limit, is it understood that the equipment can be two time the amount shown in the special note for weigh limit on structure?

Answer: Yes, one piece of equipment that exceed the weight limit at a time.

13. Manuel Gialousis:

Question: Does the lane closure have to be removed each night? (202958 Boyd County)

Answer: Yes, lane must be open if not working.

14. Manuel Gialousis:

Question: Can the lane closure remain if working day and night shifts for 24 hours? (202958 Boyd County) Answer: The lane closure will be permitted to remain as long as legitimate work is being performed. Additional measures will have to be met (lighting, etc.) in order to allow working 24 hours that will be discussed further at future pre- construction meeting.

No other questions were asked, and the meeting adjourned at 10:30 am. End of Minutes.












The contractor(s) and or subcontractor(s) performing painting operations personnel shall have been directly responsible for field operations of a structure painting project containing the requirements listed below.
- ▶ 1. A structure over a river or having multiple structures (more than three)
- ▶ 2. Having specific containment requirements
- > 3. Maintaining vehicular traffic.
- ▶ The projects shall have been completed to the facility owners' satisfaction.
- ► The Contractor(s) and or Subcontractor(s) performing the repair operations required in this contract (not paint related) shall be Pre-qualified for appropriate work items.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR BRIDGE CLEANING AND PAINTING

▶ 1. DESCRIPTION.

Perform all work in accordance with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highway's Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and applicable Supplemental Specifications, the Standard Drawings, (current editions), this Note and Attached Detailed Drawings. Section references are to the Standard Specifications. This work consists of the following: (1) Furnish all labor, materials, tools, and equipment; (2) Cleaning and Painting; (3) Maintain and control traffic; and (4) Any other work specified as part of this contract.

2. CONSTRUCTION.

- ▶ All structural steel shall be cleaned and painted in accordance with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction (current edition) Section 614.
- ▶ All structural shall be Abrasive Blast Cleaned and Painted. See Section 614.03.09 for Abrasive Blast Cleaning and Painting.


3. RECYCABLE MATERIAL.

▶ The Contractor shall bear all responsibility and expense for any and all damage to the structure including the new concrete coatings during the painting work, even to the removal and replacement of a fallen span, should the fallen span result from the Contractors actions.

- ▶ All utilities (electric see below), traffic signs shall be maintain and protected from damage.
- ▶ All electric power that shall on the structure shall be de-energized. The Contractor shall coordinate with the Department to have the power deenergized.

- Perform all work in accordance with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highway's Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and applicable Supplemental Specifications, the Standard Drawings, (current editions), this Note and Attached Detailed Drawings. Section references are to the Standard Specifications. This work consists of the following: (1) Furnish all labor, materials, tools, and equipment, (2) Bridge Cleaning, (3) Pressure Washing, (4) Concrete Coatings and (5) Any other work specified as part of this contract.
- 2. MATERIALS.
- Wash Water
- Use clean potable water for all pressure washing.
- Concrete Coatings
- See The Division of Material's list of approved materials for concrete coatings and Section 821.

- 3. CONSTRUCTION.
- ► A. Bridge Cleaning.
- All debris shall be removed from the bridge components. See attached detailed drawings for each bridge addressing components having debris removal. Equipment for removing debris from the bridge components shall be determined by the Contractor, subject to the approval of the Engineer. The Contractor shall prevent any debris from entering any body of water, bridge drainage system, or traffic lanes. All debris removed shall be disposed of in a suitable off-site disposal facility. Prior to all cleaning work, the Contractor shall confirm that any bridge drainage system is not blocked by un-removable debris. A blocked drainage system is considered to be one from which debris cannot be removed using the means specified in this note. If the Engineer has be notified, and concurs that the drainage system is blocked prior to performing other cleaning work, then proceed at the direction of the engineer. If the Contractor does not inspect the bridge drainage system and notify the engineer prior to beginning work any blocked drains will be considered to be the result of the Contractor's operations, and all clearing and cleaning of the drainage system shall be done as part of the work of the specification. All vegetation present at areas of the bridge that are to be addressed in this proposal shall be removed as determined by the Engineer.
- ► All cost to complete Debris Removal, Clean Deck Drains and Remove Vegetation shall as specified shall be included in the Lump Sum price for "Bridge Cleaning".

Pressure Washing.

- Specified bridge components shall be pressure washed. See attached detailed drawings for each bridge addressing components to be pressure washed. All equipment for pressure washing shall be operated at a minimum pressure of up 4,000 psi with 0 degree spinner tip and/or fan tips as determined by the engineer at the working location with a minimum flow rate of 3.5 gal/minute provided that these pressures do not damage any components of the structure. Pressure and flow rates shall be reduced to a level satisfactory to the Engineer should any damage occur due to power washing procedures. Pressure washing shall be operated at distance of approximately six inches from and perpendicular to the surface. All pressure washing wands shall be equipped with a gauge to accurately determine the amount pressure used. Pressure washing of any bridge element will proceed from top of wash area to bottom of wash area. Wash water will not be released to a bridge element previously washed. Preform all pressure washing at temperatures above 40 degrees Fahrenheit.
- All cost to complete Pressure Washing as specified shall be included in the Lump Sum price for Lump Sum price for "Bridge Cleaning".

- Concrete Coatings Application.
- ▶ Specified bridge components shall have concrete coating applied to as specified after debris removal and power washing. See attached detailed drawings for addressing the bridge components. Use compressed air to remove any loose debris from the surfaces that are to be coated after power washing. See concrete coating diagram.
- ▶ All coatings shall be applied within manufacturers recommended dry film thickness range. For recommended conditions for application, see Section 614.03.02 and coatings supplier specifications. Allow the surfaces to be coated to dry before any coating is applied. The coating must be applied to a clean and dry surface. All coating application shall be executed using brushes, rollers, etc. No spray application will be permitted.
- ► The Department requires acceptance testing of samples obtained on a per-lot basis per-shipment. The Division of Materials will perform acceptance testing. See Section 821.04.

Verifying Field Conditions.

► The Contractor shall be familiar with all conditions at each bridge site. The Cabinet will not consider any claims due to the Contractor having not familiarized themselves with requirements of this work.

Residual Lead.

Residual lead paint may still be on bridge. The Contractor is advised to take all necessary protective measures including worker safety and environmental regulations when performing surface preparation. The Department will not consider any claims based on residual lead paint.

Damage to the structure.

► The Contractor shall bear all responsibility and expense for any and all damage to the structure during the repair work, even to the removal and replacement of a fallen span, should the fallen span result from the contractors actions.

- Payment at the contract unit price for "Lump Sum" is full compensation for applying the concreate coatings and all incidental items required to complete this work as specified in this note and attached detailed drawings.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR MAINTAIN AND CONTROL TRAFFIC

Partment of Highways Standard Drawings No. TTC-100, TTC-110 and the FHWA Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices (current editions) unless otherwise specified. Lane closures should be used only when absolutely necessary and kept to the shortest duration possible in order to minimize disruption to the traveling public. No work will be conducted over unprotected traffic at any location. At the discretion of the Engineer, lane closures may be restricted on holiday weekends. The contractor must submit a traffic control plan for be review and approval by the KYTC Engineer 14 days prior to the Pre-Construction Conference.

1. EMERGENCY REPAIRS AND COORDINATION WITH OTHER CONTRACTS

▶ In the event it becomes necessary to make emergency repairs at this project by state forces or by other outside contractors, the (painting) contractor agrees to alter his work pattern as directed by the engineer so as not to interfere with the emergency work. The contractor shall be required to coordinate his efforts with those of any other contractor in the construction area.

2. TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

▶ The contractor will be required to furnish all traffic control devices whenever his operations endanger or interfere with vehicular traffic as determined by the engineer. The contractor shall furnish any additional traffic control devices necessary to protect traffic and his workmen. Any costs associated with the added traffic control devices (including arrow boards) shall be incidental to the contract lump sum amount for "maintain and control traffic." Placement of all devices for lane closures shall start and proceed in the direction of flow of traffic. Removal of devices shall start at the end of the construction area and proceed toward oncoming traffic. The contractor shall provide for the installation of all necessary traffic control devices before beginning work and their immediate removal as soon as work is suspended or completed. During the fully operational periods, when no lane closures are permitted, all equipment shall be totally removed from the job site. Traffic control signs shall be removed or covered (if left in a curb lane).

3. VEHICLES

- ► The contractor's vehicles shall always move with and not across or against the flow of traffic. Vehicles shall enter or leave work areas in a manner that will not be hazardous to or interfere with normal roadway traffic. Vehicles shall not park or stop except within designated work areas.
- Personal vehicles will not be permitted to park within the state right-of-way. The contractor's vehicles will be prohibited from crossing the roadway and all pedestrian movement of the contractor's personnel on the roadway will be limited to within the closed work areas.

4. TRUCK MOUNTED ATTENUATOR

▶ Any lane or shoulder closure will include the use of a Truck Mounted Attenuator placed between oncoming traffic and equipment or vehicles.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR MAINTAIN AND CONTROL TRAFFIC ~ CID 20-2953

- ▶ 5. MISC.
- ► The Contractor shall reduce the speed limit to **25 MPH** in areas signed for 35 MPH in and approaching the work zones 029B00012N.
- ► The Contractor shall reduce the speed limit to **45 MPH** in areas signed for 55 MPH in and approaching the work zones 029B00027N.
- ▶ The Engineer may elect to use Variable Message Boards when necessary.

029B00012N and 029B00027N

- Maintain one usable 12 foot minimum lane. Flagging or traffic signals shall be used. If traffic signals are used the Contractor shall use flagging to minimize impact on school bus traffic when school is in session. The Contractor shall be responsible for establishing the dates and times when school bus traffic will impact the job site.
- Only one structure will be permitted to have lane closures at a time. Any lane closure on one structure must be removed before a lane closure will be permitted on the other structure.
- To accommodate the planting and harvest seasons the contractor may be required remove the lane for passage of agricultural equipment during the harvest season. This will only require the removal of traffic cones/barrels, contractor's equipment in the lane closure and all other items that would obstruct the passage of the agricultural equipment. All temporary striping, signage, etc. will be permitted to remain. The time period will be five consecutive days. The five consecutive day period will be scheduled with coordination between the Department and the Agricultural Community to have the least impact on the Contractor's production. The lane closure removal will be required one time for each structure. A minimum two week notice will be provided to the Contractor before the lane closure removal is requested. All cost to remove the lane closure shall be considered incidental to Lump Sum bid for Maintain and Control Traffic.
- To minimize lane closures the Contractor will be permitted to remove guardrail at bridge ends where there is room to stage equipment. If this option is used the guardrail must be removed and reinstalled by a contractor that is pre-qualified for this work item. The Contractor shall be responsible for any material required to stage equipment in these areas. This material must be removed and site restored to original condition as directed by the Engineer upon completion of the project. All cost associated with using this option shall be considered incidental to Lump Sum bid for Maintain and Control Traffic.
- The Contractor will be permitted to briefly close the structure to traffic using flagging to move any **equipment that exceeds load rating only.** (See Special Note for Weight Limits on Structure) across the structure as directed by the Engineer. The equipment must be centered on the structure and shall not exceed 2 times the load rating for the structure.

The equipment must be centered on the structure and shall not exceed 2 times the load rating for the structure.
