The Department will conduct a **Mandatory** Pre-Bid Conference (by Video Conference) for the subject project. The Pre-bid video conference will be held on Monday, November 9, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time.

Any company that is interested in bidding on the subject project or being part of a joint venture shall be represented at the video conference. No individual can represent more than one company. At the video conference of the subject bridge, a roster shall be taken of the representatives present. In addition, following the video conference each company shall submit a signed affidavit listing the company members attending the video conference. The video conference will also be recorded in order to verify attendance. **Only companies represented on the video conference, have submitted the affidavit by the due date will be eligible to have their bids opened at the date of letting.**

The purpose of the video conference is to familiarize all prospective bidders with the contract requirements and the location and condition of all structures within the scope of the contract.

Department of Highways officials present at the video conference will answer questions concerning the projects.
