
Bridging Kentucky Overview

Design Build No. 1 Overview


- Address significant needs in eastern and southeastern Kentucky

Bridge Metrics

- Avg. width: 13 ½ feet (Ranges from 8'-28')
- Avg. length: 49 feet (Ranges from 21'-152')
 - **>** 83 E1 (≤70')
 - > 14 E2 (≤100')
 - > 5 E3 (>100')
- Majority are single spans





Bridge Metrics

- 79 county / 23 state
 - > 22 Class A Route
 - 1 Class AAA/Coal Haul Route
- 60+ dead-end routes
- 6 closed bridges
- ADT
 - > ~8 no data
 - **~** 48 ≤ 100
 - **~** ~23 ≤ 400
 - **>** ~17 ≤ 1,000
 - *>* ~6 > 1,000

Design Status

Preliminary Plans included in ITP:

- 13 bridges Advanced Plans
- 29 bridges Preliminary Plans
- 60 bridges Site Plans





Right of Way

- KYTC obtaining ROW identified in ITP Preliminary Plans attachment for all projects.
 - ITP to include committed dates by project
 - Majority by NTP
 - Remainder by June 1, 2020
- DBT responsible for obtaining any additional ROW.



Utilities

- Approximate utility contact list and mapping included in ITP.
- DBT responsible for utility coordination, developing agreements, and relocation.
 - Coordination costs included in lump sum bid
 - Relocation placeholder bid provided by KYTC
 - Actual invoiced relocation costs paid.
 - Betterment not eligible for reimbursement.
- KYTC review agreements and approve payments.



Environmental / Permitting

- KYTC providing environmental approvals (completed or commitment dates) in ITP.
- For unanticipated issues/impacts outside of cleared area, DBT must have prequalified team members.
 - Archaeological, historical and ecological
 - Submit results for KYTC processing with SHPO, USFWS, etc.
 - DBT must obtain modified permits for stream activity outside that identified in KYTC-provided permit.



KYTC Pre-Qualification

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR PRE-QUALIFICATION IS CURRENT.

It is <u>required</u> that the Design-Build Team (DBT) consist of a KYTC pre-qualified contractor who has engaged the services of KYTC pre-qualified Design Consultant(s) to perform all work items listed in the RFQ.

If the Design Consultant(s) submitted does not meet all required qualifications, KYTC may reject the DBT's SOQ.

Questions and Answers

Note: These questions were posed during the Mandatory Pre-Proposal Meeting on June 18, 2019 and have been reworded and/or summarized for clarity.

- Will there be opportunities for individual meetings between proposers and KYTC after the
 instructions to proposers (ITP) is released?

 <u>Answer:</u> ITP One-on-One meetings are being evaluated and will be detailed in the Draft ITP.
- Will today's presentation be shared with proposers?
 <u>Answer:</u> Yes. It is posted on the Cabinet's Design Build Projects section:
 https://transportation.ky.gov/Construction-Procurement/Pages/Design-Build-Projects.aspx
- 3. Are all 102 projects in this design-build project included in the list of Bridging Kentucky projects? <u>Answer:</u> Yes.
- 4. During the presentation, you said the design-build team (DBT) will be responsible for acquiring additional right of way not detailed in the instructions to proposers. Will KYTC pay for the cost of additional right of way, or will the design-build team be required to pay for any additional right-of-way?
 - <u>Answer:</u> Additional right-of-way needed beyond the limits shown in the ITP drawings will be the responsibility of the DBT.
- Are temporary easements being acquired, if necessary, at this time?
 Answer: Yes. Temporary easements being obtained for a bridge site will be identified in the ITP.
- 6. In the presentation, you said the design-build team will be responsible for any additional or unanticipated environmental needs. Can you expand on that?
 <u>Answer:</u> Environmentally cleared areas will be identified in the ITP. If work is proposed outside of the environmentally cleared areas, the DBT will be responsible to perform necessary field studies for these areas.
- 7. To clarify needs around right of way, is KYTC's goal to address, in the instructions to proposers, all of the right of way and environmental needed for the projects?

 <u>Answer:</u> The ITP will include right of way acquisition and environmental clearance anticipated to complete construction for the projects.
- 8. Will the design-build team be required to do a full hydraulics analysis for each project? Will the instruction to proposers include detailed information on hydraulics requirements?



<u>Answer:</u> Various levels of required hydraulic analysis will be detailed in the ITP. The goal of the program is to replace each bridge with approximately the same hydraulic opening as the existing bridge. Some projects will require detailed hydraulic analysis and some projects will require a more general Level 1 hydraulic evaluation.

- 9. For utilities, what will be provided in the instructions to proposers?

 Answer: An approximate listing of utility contacts and some utility mapping.
 - a. What would mapping include?

 Answer: Any mapping available from the utility companies will be provided.
 - Will field surveys be included?
 <u>Answer:</u> Some bridges may have utility information included in the survey. The DBT will be responsible for confirming all utilities.
- 10. This question relates to Question 17 in the Q&A, seeking clarifications on geotechnical needs.
 - a. Does the program team already have geotechnical information and boring information for each of the bridge projects?
 <u>Answer:</u> Geotechnical information will be provided for each bridge in the ITP, ranging from site observations to boring logs. Borings are not provided at all bridge sites.
 - b. Is it up to the design-build team to determine if they have enough geotechnical information?
 <u>Answer:</u> Yes. Minimum geotechnical engineering requirements to be performed by the design build team will be included in the ITP.
 - c. Will each bridge have a list identifying what the geotechnical engineer still needs to do? Answer: No. Geotechnical engineering requirements to be performed by the design build team will be included in the ITP.
 - d. When we get the IPT, can the DBT make a recommendation that they rest at what is included in ITP or that they will do additional geotechnical work?
 <u>Answer:</u> No, they cannot rest on what is included in the ITP. Geotechnical engineering requirements to be performed by the design build team will be included in the ITP. Geotechnical prequalifications are included in the RFQ based on the expectation that the DBT will be performing geotechnical work on the project.
 - e. Per Bridge?
 Answer: Geotechnical requirements of the DBT will included in the ITP at a project-wide level.
- 11. Will inspection work be part of the design-build contract?

 <u>Answer:</u> No. KYTC and the Bridging Kentucky Program Team will perform construction inspection.



- 12. Will the Design Build Team be responsible for the erosion control /BMP inspections?

 <u>Answer:</u> Requirements for any special inspections beyond the typical construction inspection performed by the cabinet will be included in the ITP.
- 13. To illustrate experience in the statement of qualifications, should procurements including multiple projects be counted as multiple projects or a single project?
 <u>Answer:</u> Experience that includes multiple projects in a single contract can be listed as a single project in the SOQ.
- 14. Is there room in this proposal for alternate design concepts?

 Answer: An alternative technical concepts process will not be utilized for this project.
- 15. During the design-build process, as the design-build team completes plans and submits to KYTC for review, will the Cabinet have a firm commitment for how long it will take to review and return those plans to the design-build team?

 <u>Answer:</u> The ITP will detail review timeframes.
- 16. Will the general engineering consultant participate in reviews of plans?

 <u>Answer:</u> The general engineering consultant team will participate in the reviews in support of the Cabinet.
- 17. Will KYTC consider providing a draft ITP to help the proposers make a decision on whether to submit a SOQ?
 <u>Answer:</u> No. The Draft ITP is under development and will be provided to the shortlisted teams on July 15, 2019.
- 18. Have you determined how many teams will be on the shortlist?

 <u>Answer:</u> No, the number of shortlisted teams will be determined by the Cabinet during the evaluation of the DBT Statement of Qualifications.
- 19. Will you consider adjusting the dates between the release of the instructions to proposers and the deadline for technical proposals?
 <u>Answer:</u> Not at this time.
- 20. Will the general engineering consultant participate in selection of the design-build team? Answer: No.
- 21. After the short listing, will the selection of the design-build team be based on the lowest bid? <u>Answer:</u> The RFQ identifies this as a Best Value selection. Details will be provided in the ITP.
