

## Legal Notice

Notice is hereby given that the City of Glasgow will accept sealed bids for the Trojan Trail Path Project in accordance with plans and specifications available at the office of American Engineers, Inc. (AEI). Bidders and Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (“DBE”) subcontractors must be prequalified with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and possess a Certificate of Eligibility at the time of the bid opening. All other subcontractors must be prequalified when accepting subcontracts. All bids exceeding \$40,000 must be accompanied with a Bid Bond of not less than 5% of the total construction bid. The Trojan Trail Project has an established DBE goal of 5%. AEI and City of Glasgow will conduct a Pre-Bid Conference for the subject project on July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at City Hall in Glasgow, Kentucky. Plans and Specifications may be obtained starting on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021 from AEI, 65 Aberdeen Drive, Glasgow, KY 42141-8238, (270) 651-7220. A non-refundable fee of One-Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) will be required for the plans and specifications. Bids will be received until July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021 until 2:00 PM CST at the City of Glasgow, Attn: Mayor Harold Armstrong, 126 E Public Square, Glasgow, KY 42141 at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read. Prospective bidders shall provide a consecutive listing of similar projects during the last three years with references and contact information. Eligible sealed bids must be clearly marked on the outside of submittal package “City of Glasgow Trojan Trail Path Project”. The City of Glasgow will evaluate all submitted bids and similar project history and reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
