UTILITY NOTES TO BE INCLUDED IN THE PROPOSAL SPECIAL NOTES FOR UTILITY CONSTRUCTION IMPACT ON CONSTRUCTION

HENRY COUNTY REPLACE BRIDGE @ US-421 AND BRANCH OF DRENNON CREEK ITEM NO. 5-1045.00

The following Utility Companies have facilities in the general project area:

LOUISVILLE GAS & ELECTRIC (GAS)

The Louisville Gas and Electric Company has an existing 4" gas main that lies to the north side of US-421 and runs east and west, crossing under the proposed bridge northeast wing wall . The relocated 4" gas main will tie into the existing main at approximate Sta.4+03 and runs west where it will tie into the existing main at approximate station 9+05. The relocation is complete.

LOUISVILLE GAS & ELECTRIC (ELECTRIC)

The Louisville Gas and Electric Company have an existing aerial facility that lies along the north side of US-421 and runs east and west. This facility is clear of construction and should not be disturbed.

AT&T-KY COMMUNICATIONS

AT&T- KY Communications has an existing facility located on the existing LG&E pole route described above. This facility is clear of construction and should not be disturbed.

HENRY COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

Henry County Water District has an existing 8" water main that lies south of US-421 and runs east and west. This facility is not in the immediate construction area and should not be disturbed.

SPECIAL CAUTION NOTE – PROTECTION OF UTILITIES

The location of utilities provided in the contract documents has been furnished by the facility owners and/or by reviewing record drawings and may not be accurate. It will be the roadway contractor's responsibility to locate utilities before excavating by calling the various utility owners and by examining any supplemental information supplied by the Cabinet. If necessary, the roadway contractor shall determine the exact location and elevation of utilities by hand digging to expose utilities before excavating in the area of a utility. The cost for repair and any other associated costs for any damage to utilities caused by the roadway contractor's operations shall be borne by the roadway contractor.

THE CALL IS TO BE PLACED A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) AND NO MORE THAN TEN (10) BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO EXCAVATION. THE CONTRACTOR SHOULD BE AWARE THAT OWNERS OF UNDERGROUND FACILITIES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE MEMBERS OF THE KY 811 ONE-CALL BEFORE-U-DIG (BUD) SERVICE. THE CONTRACTOR MUST **COORDINATE EXCAVATION** WITH THE **UTILITY** OWNERS. INCLUDING THOSE WHOM DO NOT SUBSCRIBE TO KY 811. IT MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE CONTRACTOR TO CONTACT THE COUNTY COURT CLERK TO DETERMINE WHAT UTILITY COMPANIES HAVE FACILITIES IN THE AREA.
