**SPECIAL NOTE FOR COMPLETION DATE AND
LIQUIDATED DAMAGES**

The specified date of completion shall be May 30, 2016. There will be a maximum 50 calendar day road closure allowed in order to complete the structure and approaches and reopen the road to traffic. Liquidated damages shall be charged according to Section 108.09 of the 2012 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction for every calendar day or part of a day the road remains closed beyond the allowable 50 calendar days.

Contrary to section 108.09, Liquidated damages will be assessed for the months of December through March.

Contrary to Section 108.09, Liquidated Damages will be assessed regardless of whether seasonal limitations prohibit the Contractor from performing work on the controlling operation.

All liquidated damages will be applied accumulatively. All other applicable portions of Section 108 apply.
