KY 8 will be permitted to be closed to through traffic June 1, 2017 through November 1, 2017. Failure to open November 1, 2017 will result in liquidated damages being assessed at \$2000 per day. 165 BEFORE YOU DIG

THE CONTRACTOR IS INSTRUCTED TO CALL 1-800-752-6007 TO REACH KY 811, THE ONE-CALL SYSTEM FOR INFORMATION ON THE LOCATION OF EXISTING UNDERGROUND UTILITIES. THE CALL IS TO BE PLACED A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) AND NO MORE THAN TEN (10) BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO EXCAVATION. THE CONTRACTOR SHOULD BE AWARE THAT OWNERS OF UNDERGROUND FACILITIES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE MEMBERS OF THE KY 811 ONE-CALL BEFORE-U-DIG (BUD) SERVICE. THE CONTRACTOR MUST COORDINATE EXCAVATION WITH THE UTILITY OWNERS, INCLUDING THOSE WHOM DO NOT SUBSCRIBE TO KY 811. IT MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE CONTRACTOR TO CONTACT THE COUNTY COURT CLERK TO DETERMINE WHAT UTILITYCOMPANIES HAVE FACILITIES IN THE AREA.

455 EDGE KEY

THIS WORK INCLUDES CUTTING OUT THE EXISTING ASPHALT SURFACE TO A MINIMUM DEPTH AND WIDTH AS DETAILED ELSEWHERE IN THE PLANS SO THAT THE NEW SURFACE MAY HEEL INTO THE EXISTING SURFACE. THE CONTRACT UNIT PRICE BID LINEAR FOOT (PER METER) FOR "EDGE KEY" INCLUDES ALL NECESSARY MATERIALS, LABOR AND EQUIPMENT NECESSARY TO PERFORM THE WORK AND DISPOSE OF THE REMOVED ASPHALT MATERIAL.

SPECIAL NOTES

- 1. THE EXISTING OVERHEAD UTILITY LINE RUNNING ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BRIDGE WILL REMAIN IN PLACE AND SHALL NOT BE DISTURBED BY THE CONTRACTOR. THE OVERHEAD UTILITY LINE CROSSING KY 8 NEAR STA. 123+00 WILL BE RELOCATED.
- 2. ON SITE DETOUR WILL NOT BE PROVIDED FOR THIS PROJECT, TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE WILL BE PERMITTED. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE KYTC IN WRITING THREE (3) WEEKS PRIOR TO CLOSING KY 8. PRIOR TO CLOSING KY 8 ALL TEMPORARY SIGNING AND THE DIVERSION SHALL BE IN PLACE ACCORDING TO THE MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC PLANS AND/OR BY THE APPROVAL OF THE ENGINEER. KY 8 WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE CLOSED TO THROUGH TRAFFIC JUNE 1, 2017 THROUGH NOVEMBER 1, 2017. FAILURE TO OPEN NOVEMBER 1, 2017 WILL RESULT IN LIQUIDATED DAMAGES BEING ASSESSED AT \$2000 PER DAY. THE FIXED COMPLETION DATE FOR THE PROJECT IS NOVEMBER 15, 2017. FAILURE TO COMPLETE PROJECT BY SPECIFIED FIXED COMPLETION DATE WILL RESULT IN LIQUIDATED DAMAGES OF \$5000 PER DAY, CONTRARY TO SECTION 108.09 OF THE KENTUCKY STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION

- 3. MEANS AND METHODS THE CONTRACTOR SHALL DEVELOP A DETAILED SUBMISSION INDICATING THE PROGRESSION OF WORK WITH SPECIFIC TIMES WHEN TASKS WILL BE PERFORMED FOR WORK ACTIVITIES THAT ARE ON OR IN THE VICINITY OF THE CSXT PROPERTY. THIS SUBMISSION MAY REQUIRE A WALKTHROUGH AT WHICH TIME CSXT AND/OR THE REPRESENTATIVE WILL BE PRESENT. WORK WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO COMMENCE UNTIL THE CONTRACTOR HAS PROVIDED CSXT WITH A SATISFACTORY PLAN THAT THE PROJECT WILL BE UNDERTAKEN WITHOUT SCHEDULING, PERFORMANCE OR SAFETY RELATED ISSUES. PROVIDE A LISTING OF THE ANTICIPATED EQUIPMENT TO BE USED, THE LOCATION OF ALL EQUIPMENT TO BE USED AND INSURE A CONTINGENCY PLAN OF ACTION IS IN PLACE SHOULD A PRIMARY PIECE OF EQUIPMENT MALFUNCTION. ALL WORK IN THE VICINITY OF CSXT PROPERTY THAT HAS THE POTENTIAL OF AFFECTING CSXT TRAIN OPERATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED AND APPROVED BY CSXT PRIOR TO WORK BEING PERFORMED. THIS SUBMISSION WILL ALSO INCLUDE A DETAILED NARRATIVE DISCUSSING THE COORDINATION OF PROJECT SAFETY ISSUES BETWEEN CONTRACTOR, CSXT AND THE REPRESENTATIVE. THE NARRATIVE SHALL ADDRESS PROJECT LEVEL COORDINATION AND DAY TO DAY, SPECIFIC WORK OPERATIONS INCLUDING CRANE AND EQUIPMENT OPERATIONS, ERECTION PLANS AND TEMPORARY WORKS.
- 4. CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE SUBMIT A DETAILED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT CLEARLY INDICATING THE TIME PERIODS WHILE WORKING ON AND AROUND CSXT RIGHT-OF-WAY. AS THE WORK PROGRESSES, THIS SCHEDULE SHALL BE UPDATED AND RESUBMITTED AS NECESSARY TO REFLECT CHANGES IN WORK SEQUENCE, DURATION AND METHOD, ETC.
- 5. EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN SUBMIT AN EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN INDICATING THE LOCATION OF THE SITE, CONTACT NUMBERS, ACCESS TO THE SITE, INSTRUCTIONS FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND LOCATION OF THE NEAREST HOSPITALS. THIS PLAN SHOULD COVER ALL ITEMS REQUIRED IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY AT THE SITE INCLUDING FIRE SUPPRESSION. COORDINATE THE EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN WITH THE SAFETY RELATED DISCUSSION OF THE MEANS AND METHODS SUBMISSION DISCUSSED ABOVE. THE PLAN SHOULD ALSO INCLUDE A METHOD TO PROVIDE THIS INFORMATION TO EACH PROJECT WORKER FOR EACH DAY ON SITE.
