## **Payment**

Payment of the contract lump sum amount for "maintain and control traffic" shall be full compensation for all items necessary to maintain and control traffic on this project. All traffic control items shall remain the property of the contractor when the work is complete.

### FE02 074 0092 B00007N

Maintain one usable 11 foot lane on KY 92. Flagging or traffic signals shall be used. If traffic signals are used the Contractor shall use flagging to minimize impact on school bus traffic when school is in session. Access with vertical clearance for passenger vehicles such as cars and pickup trucks to the parking area below the south side of the structure must be maintained. Contractor shall be responsible for establishing the dates and times when school bus traffic will impact the job site.

### US PARKS ACCESS ROAD.

The US Parks access road on the east end of the bridge may be used for equipment staging for the bridge cleaning and painting portion of the contract. Access with vertical clearance for passenger vehicles such as cars and pickup trucks to the parking area below the south side of the structure and access to the hiking trail entrance above the north side of the structure must be maintained. See attached detail drawing, "LAYOUT SHEET". If this option is used the Contractor shall have **45 calendar days** to use the access road. The Contractor will have the option of selecting the starting date for using the access road. Once selected, the Department shall be notified in writing of the date selected at least two weeks prior to beginning work. All work is to be completed in the 2014 construction season by November 15, 2014. See attached letter for all additional items required for using this option.

Maintain one usable 11 foot lane on KY 472. Flagging or traffic signals shall be used. Dear Mr. Mathews;

This letter is in response to your request to utilize portions of the east side trailhead parking area at Yamacraw Bridge, for staging equipment and supplies during project work on the Yamacraw Bridge, in the time period of March 01, 2014, and November 2014.

In order to approve this request, the following conditions apply:

- At least two parking spots would remain open at all times at the trailhead.
- The trailhead trash cans are not be utilized by workers on the bridge project.
- The road to the lower parking lot that goes under the Yamacraw Bridge will remain open at all times.
- All trash and debris created by the work being performed will be cleaned up on a daily basis.
- At the end of the need for the staging area, the entire staging area will be cleaned up and returned to the way it was found.
- The requested staging area would only be allowed to be used for a total of 45 calendar days with a start date and ending date sent to the Superintendent for final approval.
