SUBJECT: Suspension of Electronic Ticketing Requirements for Asphalt and Aggregate Materials

Effective immediately, KYTC is suspending the requirement for electronic ticketing of asphalt and aggregate materials. Due to contract-related issues, KYTC does not currently have an electronic ticketing portal provider under contract. Until an electronic ticketing provider is in place, material acceptance and payment will be based on paper tickets delivered to the project, consistent with previous practice. A supplemental specification outlining this change will be issued shortly.

Contractors and material suppliers that have their own electronic ticketing solution may request approval from the KYTC Project Engineer to submit electronic tickets. Approval for the use of contractor- or supplier-provided electronic ticketing systems will be at the Project Engineer's discretion. However, KYTC will not require the use of electronic ticketing until a new electronic ticketing portal provider contract has been executed.
