SUBJECT: Recyclable Material from Construction Projects

Contractors remove obsolete signs, grates, fence, reinforcement, and other miscellaneous items on many contracts throughout the state. Many of these items are hauled to a recycling facility. Recently, there have been instances of recycling facilities refusing to accept recyclable material from the project, upon recognizing that the material may be property of the Commonwealth. The Cabinet realizes that this is a problem. In an attempt to rectify the situation, a form has been developed for the contractors to provide to recycling facilities when attempting to recycle materials removed from the project. The form does require the signature of the section engineer or designee. Pursuant to Section 203 of the Kentucky Standard Specifications "REMOVAL OF STRUCTURES AND OBSTRUCTIONS," the contractor has been directed to:

Remove, wholly or in part, and dispose of fences, structures, pavements, abandoned pipelines, and any other obstructions . . . [and to] Raze, remove, and dispose of all structures, fences, and other obstructions, any portions of which are on the right-of-way.

Thus this contractor, working under contract with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, has the right to recycle or salvage material that is no longer needed or to be used.
