SUBJECT: Kentucky Method 64-202 Guidance

This memorandum provides guidance on determining the locations of the zones for the purpose of taking retroreflectivity readings. The current version of Kentucky Method 64-202 requires the number of segments and the length of the segments to be determined by the amount of a total day's striping in a section. The total day's striping shall be represented by the total miles of stripe actually placed; not roadway miles as has been accepted in the past.

In addition, KYTC has developed new Daily Striping Report (DSR) spreadsheets for paint and thermoplastic. These new sheets are available at: <https://transportation.ky.gov/Materials/pages/Chemistry.aspx>. The main feature of the new spreadsheets is the capability to generate the required random zones. In order for the spreadsheets to accurately calculate the zones according to KM 64-202 the following shall apply in order for each section to be evaluated separately:

- A separate DSR must be completed for each color
- A separate DSR must be completed for each line width
