Tonight's Meeting

This public information meeting is intended to introduce the Project Development Team to you and gather information about the project area. This meeting is the first step in the preliminary engineering and environmental assessment for several possible alternatives for the improvement of US 25. Your input is very important in the development of this project.

What we need!

Please feel free to study all the maps and displays at the meeting. Each map represents a separate section of US 25 from the US 25E intersection, near Corbin to KY 1006 at London. As the Project Development Team begins to evaluate design alternatives, we need information about the existing area. We feel this information is best gathered from the people who are familiar with the area, **YOU!**

The following are some examples of the types of information that we are looking for:

- □ Oil/Gas Wells □ Unmarked Cemeteries
- □ Hazardous Waste □ Underground Tanks
- □ Historic Structures □ Wetlands
- □ Localized Flooding □ Traffic Concerns
- □ Safety Concerns □ Access Concerns

Project Purpose

The primary goals of this project are to address highway capacity and growth needs in Laurel Co., improve safety by providing an improved route complying with current design standards, and provide an alternative route during accidents or closures on I-75.

How To Comment

Representatives of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and their Consultants are available at each of the display stations and roaming throughout the meeting. Feel free to ask them any questions that you may have about the project and they can help you identify any possible information that you may have about the area. We would appreciate it if you would take just a few moments to fill out one of our questionnaires about the project. This is the most effective way to let us know what your concerns are. These comments will be accepted until March 5, 2012. If you would like to make an oral comment, that can be accommodated, just speak to one of the project representatives.
