

# LANE CHOICE IS CRITICAL AT ROUNDABOUTS

- » Right lane is for right turns or through traffic only.
- » Left lane is for left or u-turns only.

## Pedestrians

- » Pedestrians at the curb side look left for oncoming traffic before crossing.
- » Pedestrians within island area look right for oncoming traffic before crossing.

**Yield to pedestrians**

**Left turns / u-turns:  
use left lane**

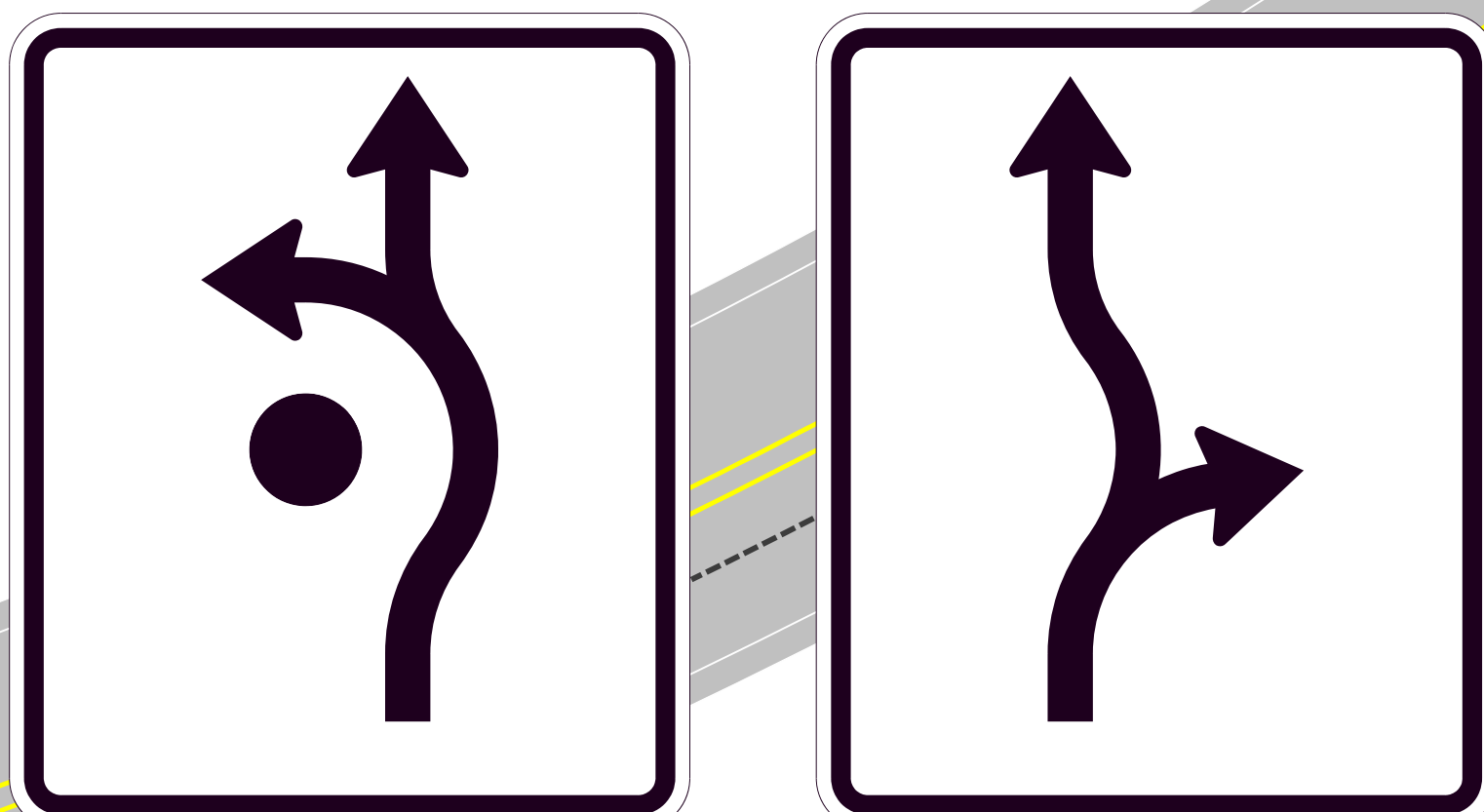
**Going straight:  
follow the pavement  
markings, arrows or signs**

**Right turns:  
use right lane**

- » Right lane is for right turns only.
- » Left lane is for left turns, u-turns, or through traffic only.

- » Right lane is for right turns only.
- » Left lane is for left turns, u-turns, or through traffic only.

## Bicycles

Bicyclists can continue  
» through the roundabout  
taking the travel lane

- » Black and white signs on the side of the road.
- » Right lane is for right turns or through traffic only.
- » Left lane is for left turns, u-turns, or through traffic only.

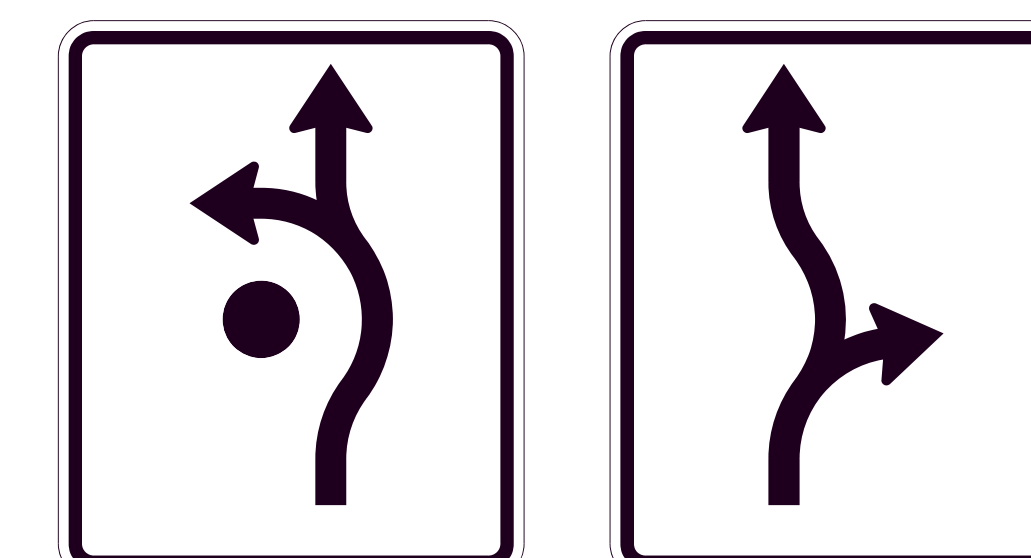
