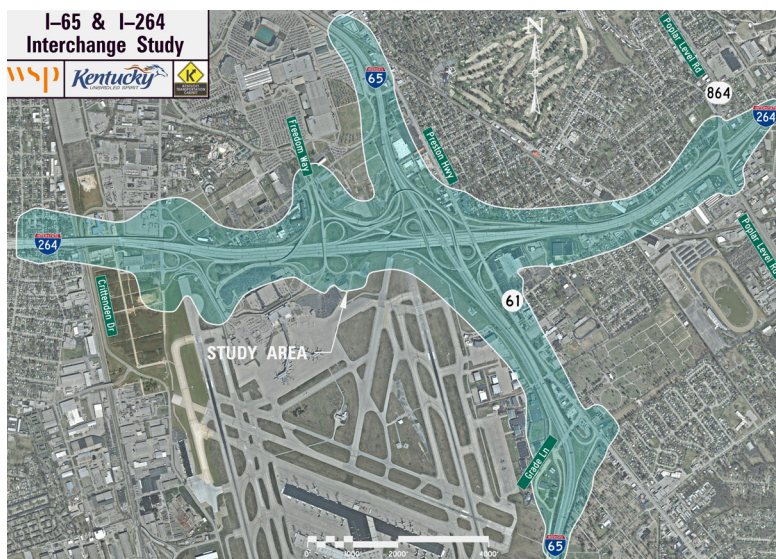


I-65/I-264 Interchange Planning Study



The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) is conducting a planning study to identify long-term and short-term improvements to the I-65/I-264 interchange.

Ranked #1 highest crash rate interchange in the Kentuckiana Regional Planning & Development Agency (KIPDA) MPO region



PROJECT GOALS

- Manage and Reduce Congestion
- Improve Safety
- Improve Access Departing and Entering Region
- Ensure Reliability for Timely and Efficient Movement
- Mitigate Negative Environmental Impacts

TIMELINE

- Fall 2019:** Study begins analyzing safety, roadway characteristics and traffic data.
- Spring 2020:** Public involvement to gather feedback on existing conditions.
- Summer 2020:** Project Team analyzes feedback and data and develops proposed improvements.
- Fall 2020:** Public involvement to gather feedback on proposed improvements.
- Winter 2020:** Project Team analyzes feedback and submits final report to KYTC.
