ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC), in partnership with the City of Frankfort, has begun preliminary design for a new **U.S. 60X 'Singing Bridge'** over the Kentucky River. This marks a major step toward replacing the historic 132-year-old bridge, which has been closed to the public since August 2024 due to significant structural deterioration.

PURPOSE AND NEED

Following months of detailed analysis and structural assessments, KYTC engineers, consultant teams and contractors have determined that a full replacement of the existing bridge is the safest and most viable option to maintain this vital downtown connection. The new bridge will continue to link Downtown and South Frankfort along St. Clair Street, preserving an essential route for residents, businesses and visitors while honoring the historic and cultural importance of the beloved **Singing Bridge.**
